New: He asked, "Have you finished your homework...yet?"

*How does the new **punctuation** change the meaning of the sentence? (Think why he's saying that way)*

Station 4

Original: Mom: Don't forget to lock the door.

New: Mom: Don't forget to lock the door!

*How does the new **punctuation** change the meaning of the sentence? (Think why Mom would say it different)*

Station 5

Original: (Student) Can you help me with this?
I'm really struggling.

New: (Student) Can you help me with this? I'm
really struggling?!
