

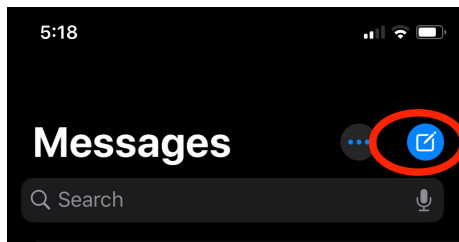


The Masked Reader

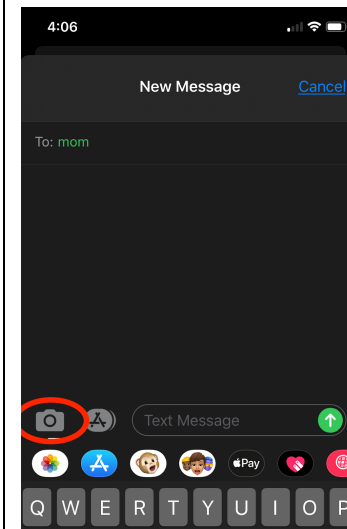
- In order to create a Memoji/Animoji video, you need to have an iPhone X or later, which has the TrueDepth camera software.
- If you have an iPad, it has to be iPad Pro 12.9 inch (3rd generation or later), or iPad Pro 11 inch
- To see what model iPhone or iPad you have, go to [Settings > General > About](#) and it should list the Model name

STEPS:

1) Open Messages and tap to start a new message (or go to an existing conversation)



2) Tap the Camera icon to go to the Camera app



3) Swipe to select Video



4) Tap the star button to bring up the special effects



5) Tap the monkey face to select the animoji you'd like to use for your "mask"

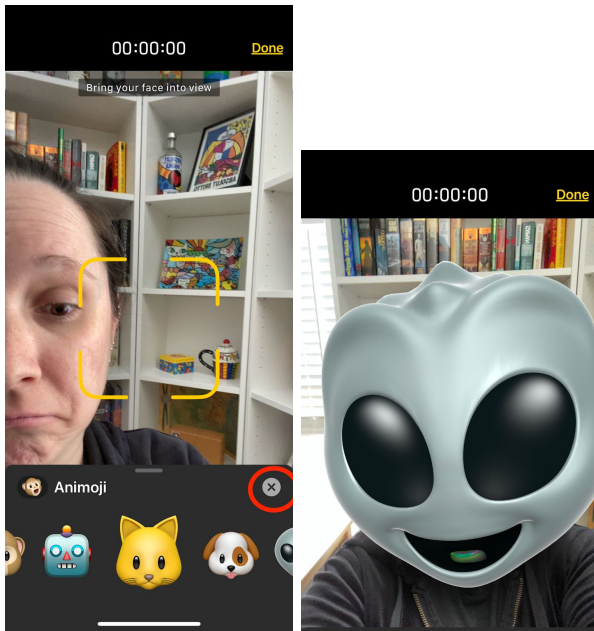


6) Swipe left to select

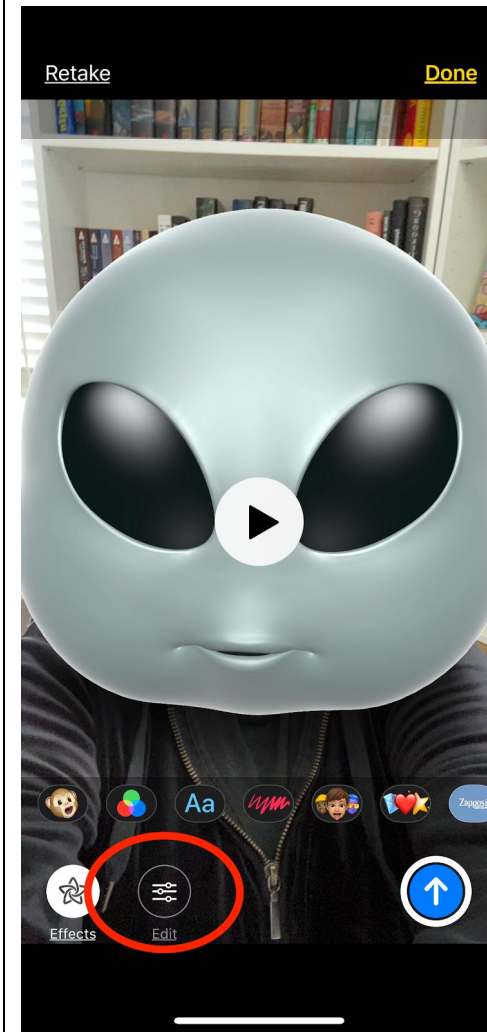


Once you've clicked on the animoji you want, click the x on the bottom right, then press record when you're ready

Once you are finished, press the red button to stop filming, but don't press "Done"



Click Edit in the bottom left corner to "create" the movie and then edit it



Click the rotate button (square)



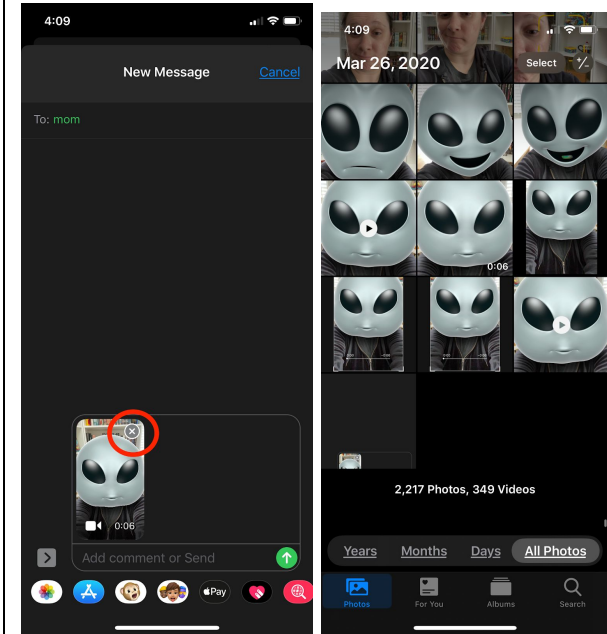
Click the flip button (pyramid) to flip the video so words aren't backwards



Click Done,
twice



When you

TIPS AND TRICKS:

- You can't be too far away from the camera, or it will revert back to your normal face - be careful while filming that you don't move around too much.
- Be careful not to block any part of your face with the book you are reading (like when you want to show the illustrations). That will also cause the camera to revert back to your normal face
- If you look down, the animoji closes its eyes - I tried to hold the book up higher so when I was reading, I wasn't looking down
- The more exaggerated your facial expressions are, the more defined the animoji's expressions will be
- Be aware of what's behind you :)
