Kyle: yes thank you

Keith: Olivia...

Keith: that's forward thinking and I respect that

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: well in fourth grade miss flowers pulled me out of my room after we took global scholar tests and she was she had these envelopes and I had no idea what she was saying so I was so confused about what this was and then I was like you know what I'm gonna do it and it turned out being really fun and I enjoyed it a lot I learned a bunch of new things I met a bunch of new people I went to a lot of new places and I think it'll help me in the long run because I want to go to Brookstone and also I want to go to Johns Hopkins School of Medicine because I want to study to be a surgeon

Kyle: cool very very cool and you're in the what grade now

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: fifth

Kyle: fifth grade yeah I'm sure I was thinking about college in the fifth grade

Keith: no no and out of the two of us I would be more likely

Kyle: yeah absolutely

Keith: so I want to go back to something that Kate said which is so what are some of the places that you've gotten to go as in Scholars Bowl that you hadn't before

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: Mississippi. we went to like uh wait was it Birmingham or Montgomery? for what? the lamp school... oh that was Montgomery. we went to alabaster I didn't even know they existed

Keith: yeah, some of the people who live in Alabaster don't even know they exist

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: we have the subsidiaries outside of Huntsville and the surrounding communities

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: just really where place called Mississippi. didn't they give us sweet tea or something? Texas makes steak. We also went to Hoover.

Keith: Hoover, yeah that's a north side of Birmingham

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: we just recently went to Birmingham for the state convention hmm and no it was really fun I stayed in a room with my best friend so it wasn't like I stayed in a room with someone I hated

Kyle: that's important

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: so basically they'll give you like this random question and if you know it you'll buzz in if it's right you'll get ten points for your team and you'll move on to the next round well bonus questions and then they'll give you like two sets of questions you can end up getting about 30 points if you get all of them right and if you get it wrong the other team has time to try to guess it and they can get bonuses too

Kyle: so let me ask this your team is answering questions along side how many other teams

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: one

Kyle: just one so it's one one versus one team versus one team and so

Keith: it sounds like a bracket like March Madness with the brackets the okay

Kyle: so if you beat whoever gets the most points there advances down and then we go okay okay

Keith: and so then do you keep your bracket so you can frame it with your path of destruction along the way to victory like Sherman's march to the sea and I think this group might know what I'm talking about

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: no, not at all

Keith: Sherman's March to the Sea?!?

Kyle: they're not there yet

Keith: Civil War? Union General Sherman?

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: meh. we totally skipped the Civil War

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: since we're talking about competitions I want to say something about losing because we are gonna lose and it's really upsetting when we do

Kyle: sure

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: and it's like Shh when it happens it's just like well we did good we tried our best and even if it's like they won 300 to 0 we we still we still tried and if when we win we're not gonna rub it in their faces we're gonna shake their hands say good game like they would us and even if they rub it in our faces we're not gonna rub it in theirs

Keith: yes, miss flowers

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: I was just gonna say a lot of times we go to these tournaments, there's not an elementary division, so we are in with the Junior High

Kyle: really?!?

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: so winning just makes it so much better

Keith: all the sweeter

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: so there are some times when we could get pretty much creamed but we learn from it and I never see anything but respect they're giving each other and the other team

Kyle: and of course we were we were joking earlier with the crushing people and all this other yeah we were we all know that we were just kidding there you mean you're going against kids two and three years older than them

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: ya

Keith: respect

Kyle: yeah absolutely okay so that's how the competition works oh they're gonna ask you a set of questions that is seemingly random how do you guys prepare for that

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: at the beginning of everything we got this big book and it was a book of cultural literacy and I've read like half the book and so that's how I prepare because it's just a bunch of categories and these are all the categories that they asked us so reading I want to read the whole book I haven't yet I'm planning to do that this summer but reading the whole book helps us prepare because it's all these categories and that's the questions they're asking us so you'll have a information for the games

Kyle: so let me clarify the book is a big book of questions and answers or it is a book of like general topics like let me tell you about how this works let me tell you about how this works

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: it's just they'll give you a big section like medical or mythology or folklore it'll give you a word and then they'll give you a definition of that word

Keith: the new dictionary of cultural literacy

Kyle: Wow you said you have read half of this book

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: I have read the medicine and health section the literature section the mythology and folklore section and I've read like two or three others so just

Keith: so just just starting off the Bible mythology and folklore proverbs idioms world literature philosophy and religion literature in English conventions of written English fine arts world history both have both halves American history both halves world politics American politics world and American geography anthropology psychology and sociology business thinking business and economics physical sciences and mathematics earth sciences life sciences medicine medicine and health technology this is Wikipedia before there was Wikipedia

Kyle: yeah yeah I mean it looks like an old school dictionary

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: basically the best thing to do is flip to a random page

Kyle: and learn something from there

Keith: don't fire until you see the whites of their eyes a famous command attributed to William Prescott an American officer at the Battle of Bunker Hill in the Revolutionary War

Kyle: Wow

Keith: Prescott's command has become proverb meaning don't act before you have some chance of success I mean

Kyle: and so you'll just you will just take time and I'm guessing you have practice sessions

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: every morning every single morning. we practice here every Thursday morning and then at the junior high they offer some afternoon practices where they can ride the bus over. South has a team as well, so they'll get together and practice and then I do have a handful that have been coming to my room in the morning every single morning and practicing before school

Kyle: really

Keith: that's awesome. let me tell you something a book like this would have been my best friend when I was y'all's age. I would have loved a book like that I would have been even more insufferable if

Kyle: you would have been

Keith: but I still would have enjoyed the book so before a competition do you know where or do you just okay everybody needs to pick a part of this book and memorize it basically or do you know before the competition hey we're gonna cover politics and religion or something like that

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: no. we never know. it's not as completely random as you might think there's a couple subjects that are the majority of the questions like science history literature geography. those are the main things. i one of my like very good subjects as medicine helps so every time I get one I buzz in and I say that answer but one time I said trachea instead of nose and Caitlin she's not here right now because she's not on the scholars' bowl team yet she had said nose she had buzzed and said it and the other team they didn't even try to buzz in and say nose after she said it out loud after I buzzed in and I was like I and I'm a little disappointed with this team because there it does state convention and they didn't try they didn't meet least try to get the answer they just sat there they were like okay

Kyle: so I get the feeling

Keith: disrespect my enemies for not being on their game

Kyle: I get the feeling what you lot are very competitive

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: we are

Kyle: is that true is everyone very competitive here it's just like some people aren't some people are

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: sometimes, working as a team, we try to one up each other like see who can answer the most questions yes and like with if I'm on a team with reece he's gonna get more questions than me if I'm on a team with let's say somebody newer then I most likely gonna get more questions because I've been in scholars' bowl since fourth grade along with Ciara so I've been in it longer than most because everybody joined this year because we didn't have it last year

Kyle: right so I'll give you guys are just a hair of a history lesson when we came through a hundred thousand years ago they only had scholars Bowl at the high school level so the only time we could ever engage in it was past ninth grade but ninth grade was the year you got to like test in and then you could do it 10 11 and 12 it's the only time so the fact that you guys have it as early as you do is fantastic

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: yeah and that is showing in our junior high and our high school teams as they're doing really well, too

Keith: because you're just you're feeding into it they're doing nothing but benefit from that

Kyle: well man it's like if you read half this book this year you read the next half next year you'll know all of it

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: well...she says she doesn't exactly memorize it. I mean if I hear the question it's like everything is in my memory but I can't just like say it all like right now but if I hear the question I'm gonna be like I know the answer to this

Keith: so give me an example of the question

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: okay um you can like open up to one and then like find a word and try to turn it into a question and then we'll see if we can answer it

Keith: okay this place was the location of a failed attempt by Cuban exiles to invade Cuba in 1961

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: hmmmmm....I'm not really into history. port? geography! St. Paul.

Keith: alright edit point

Kyle: you gotta tell them the answer!

Keith: oh, Bay of Pigs

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: OH!!! I would not have gotten that.

Keith: it's the Bay of Pigs. so there are a few areas that they're gonna pull mostly from your history or science your literature okay and then so but then to the rest of y'all sort of specialize and we're gonna all right so we're all gonna know the core things and then I'm also going to take idioms or whatever

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: no people specialize in the core things we rarely ever get mythology for so for so many people to know it it's just like a competition to see you can get like the mythology questions right cuz like I'm gonna team with Reece it's just and we hear a mythology question we're gonna be like had the buzzer at our hands ready at any time to buzz in and if he buzzes in before me and gets the answer right I'm gonna be mad because I wanted to do it. but then both of them are gonna be mad if the other team buzzes in and gets it right

Keith: it's like sure there's no I in team, but there sure is an M and an E! well so first of all do you know what Trivial Pursuit is okay

Kyle: so Trivial Pursuit is exactly what you guys do in board game form yeah and so you can get Trivial Pursuit for different themes or they can just be general knowledge and for those who don't know you start in the center you have a little piece of pie and there's five or six pieces of pie each one represents a Content area knowledge base there

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: isn't there a harry potter trivia

Kyle: there is a Harry Potter Trivial Pursuit, there's a Lord of the Rings Trivial Pursuit so there's all kinds of things like that

Keith: it's like monopoly these days

Kyle: so you go around the board and you get the pieces and it's literally just scholars Bowl as a board game

Keith: so I guess what our point is

Kyle: you would be really good at

Keith: get that for next family game night and

Kyle: embarrass your family

Keith: make all of your family cry do it at Thanksgiving it will make you so popular

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: my family does not play board games with me

Keith: oh yeah

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: I mean my brother to play chess with me because I chess is one of those board games that I love and only my sister knows how to play it and I'm too lazy to teach anybody else in my family too because they'll just feel like they'll just I'm I'm not very good at teaching people because I just get frustrated but when they don't understand

Kyle: it's hard to see six moves down the road and them not be able to figure out the one move that's that's difficult to be in

Keith: that's me I have no one I can't figure out the one move

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: In Kindle, we're having a chess tournament to see who's going to the chess tournament and right now I'm undefeated for my grade, but I still have like 2 or 3 more people (stage whisper: I'm undefeated too!). I only got one stalemate.

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: I was playing against this one person today and we were playing and he had I had a plan to move his queen out of the way and move my rook over so that I sit right there and then I moved and he had nowhere to move because all he was all blocked and I was like check mate and it was like five seconds into the game there's actually a thing called three move checkmate

Kyle: I've heard of that I don't know how to do it but

Kyle: alright so let me ask this question when's the most recent tournament you guys went to

Kyle: miss flowers how do you handle the egos in your group here

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: oh we have very high egos

Keith: we've noticed

Keith: so Micah won with Reese let's go with Olivia

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: cool thing that I like is going on the trips I socialize a lot so I get to know people a lot more when we go on trips

Keith: hey Payton what's the coolest thing you've gotten to do on the scholars' bowl man

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: it's mostly the traveling that I like the most but we won second place and I did the most in that one, well most I've done ever. You don't try your best in any other?

Keith: we are learning

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: yes

Keith: Kyle, not only are you and I learning things but they're learning things about each other

Kyle: this is a really good session we're having

Keith: we're gonna bill them like \$100 an hour. all right let's go with Kate

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: the bus rides the bus rides are amazing we get to chill with our pals we get to chill with friends

Keith: do you get a full big ol' bus to yourselves

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: no we share with like South or the Junior High we get the front of the bus to ourselves I want it

West Smiths Station Elementary School Scholars' Bowl Team: no the back of the bus is just bad! the junior high kids with their creepy selves
