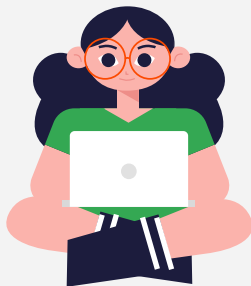

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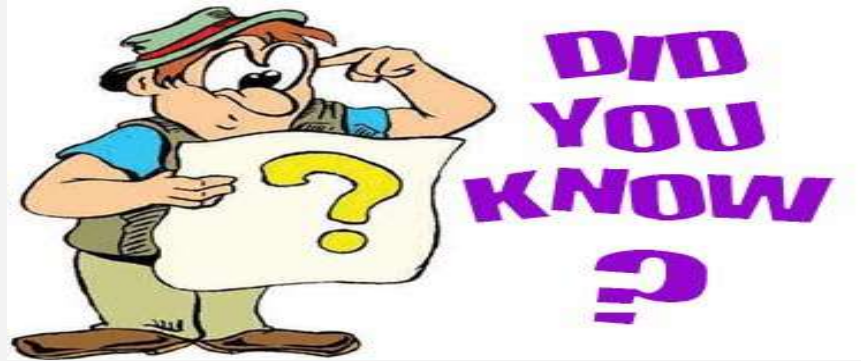
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What are A-G Requirements ?

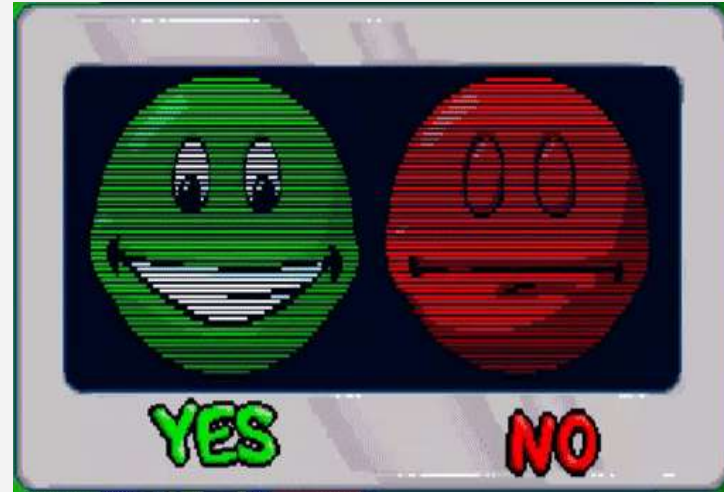

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CTE Pathways



- Foothill offers CTE pathways that give students the opportunity to explore and become skilled in one of five areas of study while completing a “G” elective (and Intro to Engineering can be used as an “F” elective). In order to complete a pathway and graduate with a pathway cord, students must pass a concentrator and completer course in the same area.



*Optional electives can be used as the intro or completer courses can be taken as an elective in addition to other coursework.




