Step 4 - Select your Course Sequence for English, Math, Life Science, History, World Lang, PE, and Electives (Choose your Pathway)




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Step 5 - Click the bottom "Apply the Selection" to populate your 4-year plan. If you need to make changes, hover over the class and select the trash can icon to delete the class.




Step 7 - If you are missing a requirement, click on the subject needed and choose an individual course from the drop-down list.




Step 8 - Once complete, click on "Submit my Plan for Counselor Review" and FINISH!!
