Still need a parent or several parents to chair the silent auction committee. • Butter Braid sales start next Monday. Email available to send to all parents. Isaac will send out to all parents to inform them of the fundraiser. Delivery will be Thursday, November 10th (the week band leaves for Las Vegas). • Texas Roadhouse fundraiser in early spring...lunch with ticket price is \$10 with the band getting \$8. Plan to use revenue to put towards the big trip. • March A Thon...need to redo the form for next year as the instructions were unclear. Plan to have kids write thank you notes to everyone who made a donation. • Financial Committee still waiting to have tax accountant complete the taxes...currently have an extension until November. 	
New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the Note Spring addition articles need to be in by January 13th with plan to send out January 20th. • Christina and Kerri will provide snack bags for the last game due to the difficulty in keeping space for band saved. • This school year all volunteers need to fill out form to have child abuse registry check run...next year it will most likely be fingerprinting. • Volunteer hours need to be turned in about 2 days before the end of each month. • Janice has agreed to be head chaperone. Need to have a chaperone meeting to get the forms completed. Goal is to have one chaperone meeting for both Las Vegas and State meeting. • Hotel request has been completed by Isaac for \$79/night in Fort Collins...48 rooms for state competition for a total of \$3,200. • Regionals is scheduled for Thursday with GJHS playing at 2:45pm.
