*Annotating means marking up your books for ALL of the following:

- Underline or highlight key passages (This should occur throughout the chapter frequently, but not too frequently.)
- Write a one-sentence summary of the chapter on the final page of <u>each</u> chapter
- Note questions, thoughts, connections, comments, and/or challenges in the margins (4-5 times <u>per</u> chapter)
- Underline and label three to five uses of figurative language or rhetoric <u>per book</u>. (metaphor, simile, personification, irony, parallelism, repetition, rhetorical question, imagery, etc.)
