

10th Grade Course Progression Guide

Please use this guide as a planning tool during registration. The Course Selection Sheet was handed to students in Advisory and is posted on the West Counseling Canvas Page.

- **English (4 credits are required):** Writing for Publication, Composition, Advanced Composition, AP Lit. & Composition, AP Lang. & Composition, AP Seminar, British Lit., Black Lit., World Lit., Creative Writing, Media Communication and Contemporary Novels.
- **Math (3 credits are required):**
 - Geometry → Algebra 2
 - Algebra 2 → Pre-Calculus or Discrete Math and Statistics
 - Pre-Calculus → AP Calculus AB / BC or AP Statistics
 - AP Calculus AB → AP Calculus BC or AP Statistics
 - AP Calculus BC → Calculus 3.
- **Science (3 credits are required):** Physics, Advanced Physics, AP Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Physics (1, 2, C), Astronomy, Environmental Science, Anatomy and Physiology.
- **Social Studies (3 credits are required):** American Public Policy, American Public Policy Hybrid, or American Public Policy Special Emphasis.

Next select your elective classes.

- 11th graders frequently complete their Financial Literacy requirement, choose one class from the following: Business and Personal Finance, Economics, or Independent Living.
- If you have not completed your Oral Communication or Health credit, don't forget that is a graduation requirement.
- Remember you also need 1.5 credits (3 semesters) of Physical Education to graduate.

You can choose up to 7 classes per semester.
