

## HOME HOSPITAL CLASSROOM

Home Hospital is a temporary placement designed to accommodate each students' individual needs.

Home Hospital is a program in which curriculum is tailored for each student, as determined by their Individual Education Plan (IEP).

Students work on goals and objectives from their IEP while earning credits towards appropriate promotion from their home school.

## INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAM

Independent Study Program is a voluntary program.

- Students remain part of their home school student body.
- Students take general education, college preparatory courses, using the same district-approved curriculum as the comprehensive high schools.
- Students who are interested in Independent Study should contact their high school counselor.
- Students will need a medical note and agree to participate in the program for a minimum of one semester.

## TRACY YOUNG ADULT PROGRAM

Serves young adults as determined by their Individual Education Plan

## George and Evelyn Stein High School

Stein prides itself in giving students a second chance to succeed in school. Serving 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who are at least 16 years of age, the school's **primary goal** is to help students earn their high school diploma by the end of their senior year in high school.

- Students are referred by a counselor from a TUSD comprehensive high school or transfer from other alternative education programs.

Students who move to TUSD from other continuation high schools enroll directly into Stein High.

### Stein Offers

- An Academic Advisor for each student who assists them with developing a plan to recover credits and to get back on track to graduate.
- Each Advisor is also a current teacher at Stein.
- Smaller classes sizes than that of the comprehensive high schools.
- Online classes where students can recover additional credits at a self-guided pace.
- Individual and group counseling.
- Customized programming to meet each student's needs.
- All graduates complete school with a student portfolio that includes but is not limited to letters of recommendation, a scholarship essay, a record of completed community service and graduate exit survey.

## Duncan Russell Community Day School (DRCDS)

**DRCDS** is an alternative education school that serves:

- Expelled students
- Students referred by the Discipline Review Board (DRB)
- Students referred by the School Attendance Review Board (SARB)
- Back-On-Track Program: 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students deficient in credits and not eligible for attendance at the continuation high school.

**Our goal** is to assist at-risk youth to overcome academic and behavioral barriers that have hindered school success.
