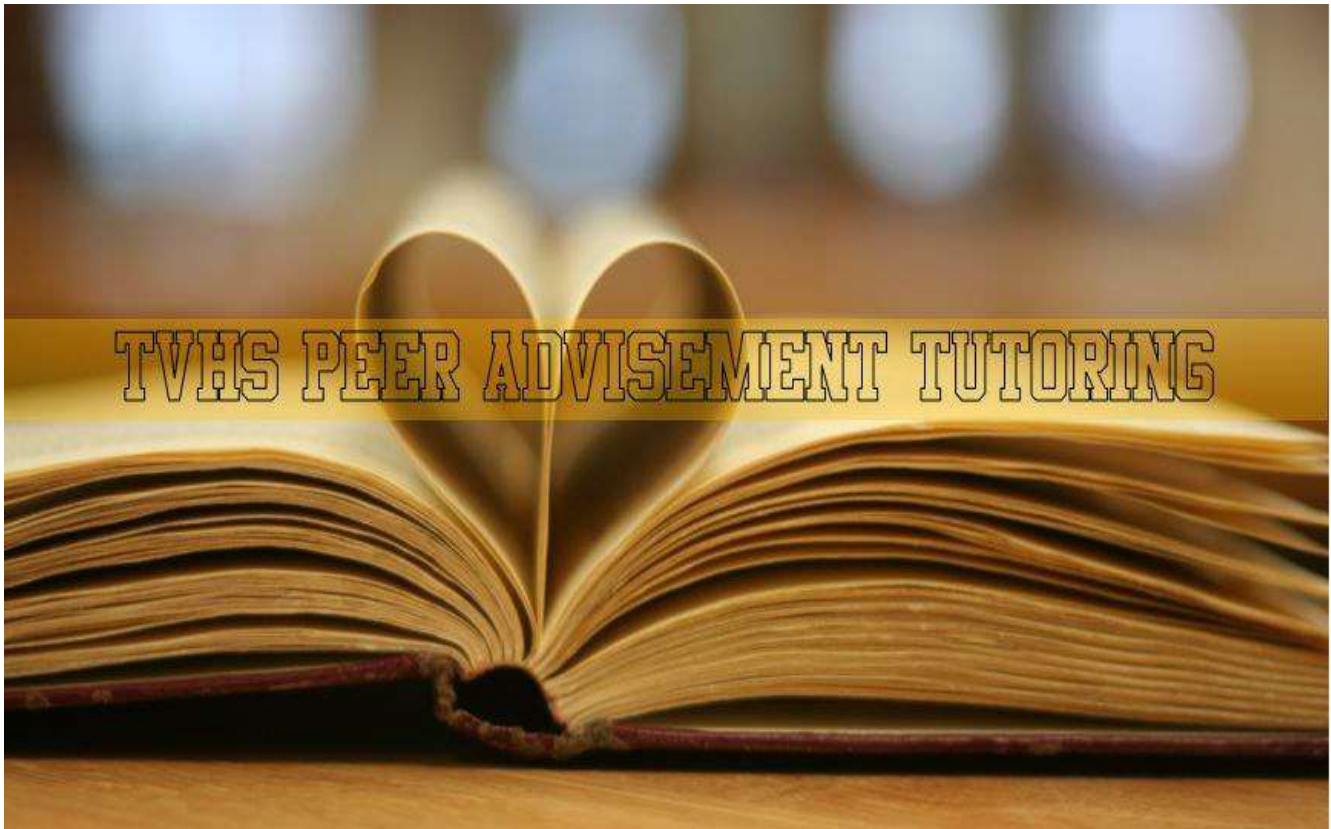

#### 1) Elks Most Valuable Student Competition - \$50,000 - 500 Awards (Deadline: November 15, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- B) Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.
