

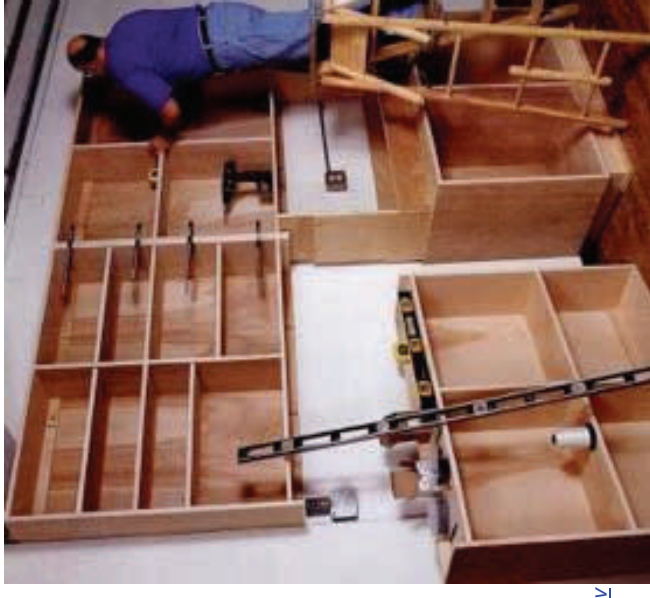
TRI-COUNTY ROP FURNITURE & CABINET CONSTRUCTION

The Furniture and Cabinet Construction program is designed to give students instruction in the design and construction of furniture and cabinets. The course will help the students understand the processes that meet industry standards. Students will be exposed to a variety of activities that will aid in his/her understanding of furniture and cabinet making for future employment. A selection of required cabinets for home, office, and industrial use will be constructed by class members to give the students “hands-on” training. Instruction will be given on the proper use of power tools and shop safety. Students will also receive instruction in job preparedness including learning to complete and employment application and prepare a resume.
