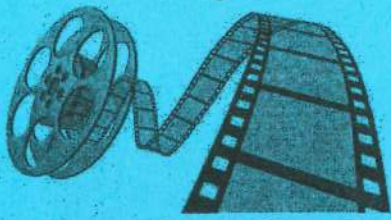


Mayfair High School 2023 Prom Contract

YOU MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS READY WHEN PURCHASING YOUR TICKET(S)

1. Current School I.D. card (if lost, please go to the Library & pay \$5.00 for a new one)
2. PHOTOCOPY of your guest's school I.D. card or Driver's License (if you are bringing a guest)
3. Contract Signed by you & your parent/guardian (required of ALL students, regardless of your age)
4. Cash, VISA/MC. NO REFUNDS will be given for any reason. All sales are final!

DANCE CONTRACT: This contract signed by you and your parent/guardian is required prior to purchasing a ticket and attending this high school dance. Each Mayfair Junior or Senior must have their own contract. Mayfair students in 9th or 10th grade must be listed as a guest on a Junior or Senior's contract. If you will be taking a guest (under age 21) that is not a Mayfair student, you will also need the guest's signature, and their parent's signature, along with a photo copy of their current ID, and their school counselor's approval. There will be NO REFUNDS. Please review All information carefully before signing.

WHO: Prom is for students in grades 11 & 12, with Good Attendance, without fines, or past due library/textbooks, and their guest (under age 21). New parameters for attendance have been adopted - please see the TICKET POLICY section for details. Underclassmen in grades 9 & 10 are only permitted to attend as a guest of an 11th or 12th grader. Absolutely no middle school students are allowed at any high school dance. MHS Administration and staff reserve the right to refuse admittance to any person as they see fit. Students who are absent or tardy more than 95% of the time are subject to being placed on the "No-Go" list. Students on the restricted or No Go list must clear all detentions and be in good standing prior to purchasing a ticket.

DRESS CODE: Prom is a formal event. **SCHOOL DRESS CODE MUST BE FOLLOWED.** Girls must wear a formal dress. Boys must wear a tuxedo or suit with tie. **Revealing or inappropriate attire will not be permitted.** Please note the following guidelines and restrictions.

- * No exposed bare midriff or body parts (including mesh, see-through, or cutouts).
- * No slits higher than mid thigh.
- * No cleavage.
- * Open backs cannot fall below the natural waist.
- * A dress of an appropriate length is one that stays at fingertip length or longer when walking and dancing. If the dress rises above fingertip length when walking and dancing, it is not an appropriate length.
- * No gang attire.
- * No oversized clothing.
- * No baggy clothes, shorts, or jeans.
- * No hats or baseball caps.

Remember this is a school-sponsored dance and you want to be able to move freely without excessive exposure, discomfort, and/or violating any of the above guidelines. If you have any questions regarding the suitability of your attire, see Mrs. Lane, Assistant Principal, in the Front Office. **If you are in violation of the stated dress code, you will not be allowed into the dance. A parent or guardian will be contacted to bring you the appropriate attire before you are allowed to enter the dance or you will be sent home without a refund.**

PICTURE I.D. is required by you and your guest **to be admitted into the dance.** Mayfair students must have a *CURRENT* school I.D. or pay an additional \$5.00 for a replacement I.D., available in the Library. If your guest is not a Mayfair student, they must give you a photocopy of their *CURRENT* I.D. to purchase a ticket and also present the same *CURRENT* photo I.D. at the dance. **FAILURE TO BRING AN I.D. TO THE DANCE will result in not being admitted into the dance.**

GUESTS FROM OTHER SCHOOLS & GRADUATES: You may invite one guest from another high school, who is in good standing. An administrator's (counselor) signature and school stamp (seal embosser or address stamp) is required on the guest section of the contract. Students who are enrolled in middle school may not attend. If the guest is not a high school student, a photocopy of guest's *driver's license* must be provided at the time of ticket purchase. Age: Guests must be under the age of 21. As a guest at a Mayfair dance, guests agree to be under the jurisdiction of the school and must follow all school rules. As a Mayfair student sponsor, you are responsible for your guest at all times and may be disciplined or fined for the actions of your guest. Guests are permitted into the event only in the company of the Mayfair student sponsor and must leave when the sponsor leaves. Failure to follow the stated rules of this contract may be grounds for removal from this event.

GUEST APPROVAL: Guests from another school or guests already graduated from high school must be approved by Mrs. Lane. Take your signed contract and copy of your guest's I.D. to the Administration Office. **Guest approval takes 48 hours in our office,** so turn it in by Wednesday if you plan to purchase tickets on Friday. Guests must be approved *BEFORE* you can purchase your tickets.

DRUGS, TOBACCO & ALCOHOL: All of the schools rules apply to you and your guest at this school sponsored event. If you or your guest are suspected of being under the influence, you will be subjected to further testing and/or escorted out of the dance, without a refund.

Dance Attendance

- All students are expected to be at the dance within one hour (1) after the dance begins. If you arrive later, you will not be allowed to enter the dance.
- Students must remain at the dance once they have entered the dance. If students leave the dance, they will not be allowed to return.
- Students may leave the dance 30 minutes before the end time of the dance.
- Students who need to leave earlier than 10:30 must have parent permission to do so.

TICKET POLICY:

1. All financial obligations and overdue library/textbooks must be cleared prior to purchasing tickets.
2. Students with a record of multiple Tardies or Absences may be denied the opportunity to purchase a ticket and are possible grounds for exclusion from Prom. **Starting March 28, 2023** – Unexcused Absences must not exceed 3 or more periods or 1 Full day Unexcused in 1 week; Tardies and/or Tardy Sweeps must not exceed 3 or more in 1 week. Approvals may be granted by April 26, if the Tardy and absence record shows improvement. Please see Mrs. Lane for approval.
3. The person who purchased the tickets may CHANGE "GUESTS" if: (1) he/she informs the other person no longer attending, (2) he/she turns in a new contract, signed by the student's parent/guardian, with new date's information & required signatures.
4. All tickets must be purchased from the school ASB Accounting Office. All tickets are sold to specific individuals with signed contracts. **TICKETS MAY NOT BE GIVEN, SOLD, OR EXCHANGED TO OTHER STUDENTS.**
5. NO REFUNDS will be given to anyone for any reason prior to or after the dance.
6. NO REFUNDS will be given to students who do not show up to the dance or are not allowed to enter the dance area due to improper dress or behavior, or use or possession of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.

COST: Refer to the price table below. ASB card discounts apply ONLY to the student who purchased the ASB card, and their NON-MAYFAIR guest. When purchasing tickets, you agree to the ticket policy as detailed above.
