# Career & Military Assessments

ASVAB – For military entrance

Offered at CHS each semester. Students may choose take in 11<sup>th</sup> grade and again in 12<sup>th</sup> grade. ASVAB is a great career resource also!

R2W – For careers

11<sup>th</sup> grade students will take in the spring. Students will receive a certificate of workforce readiness.

The ASVAB and R2W are both free.

# ACT and SAT

Both the ACT and the SAT are offered 6 times per year on Saturdays and once during the school day at CHS.

ACT – For four year colleges and universities. Register and request test scores on line at <http://www.act.org/>.

SAT – For four year colleges and universities. Register and request test scores on line at <http://www.collegeboard.org/>.

Waivers for SAT/ACT– See your counselor if you qualify for free or reduced lunch

You will have the opportunity to take the SAT or ACT for free next year during the school day.

# Hope, LIFE and Palmetto Fellows

*Requirements may increase next year. These scholarships are guaranteed as long as you meet the requirements below. Students can only claim one scholarship. For use ONLY at SC colleges and universities.*

Hope – use at a four year college. \$2600/year; one year only

- 3.0 GPA or higher

LIFE – use at a two year college. \$5000/year for two years

- 3.0 GPA or higher

LIFE – use at a four year college. \$5000/year for four years.

- 3.0 GPA plus test score (24/1100) or top 30%

Palmetto Fellows – use at a four year college.

\$6700/1<sup>st</sup> year, \$7500/2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> year.

- Top 6% of your class AND test score (27/1200) OR
- 4.0 GPA AND test score (32/1400)

# High School Majors/ Cords/ Seals

Not required for graduation

South Carolina Department of Education has formalized the completer program.

Students are recognized at graduation with a cord signifying the completed major

This has no impact on college entrance

# TWO NEW COURSES FOR NEXT YEAR

## **Trending: Global Communication in a Digital World – Grades 10-12 – 1 Credit**

This course will focus on Social Media communication and personal responsibility. Students will learn how to communicate in a connected world, and will address the challenges associated with social media and other digital communications. Students will explore the history of social media, law and ethics, writing structure and process, as well as exploration of digital marketing and network media. There will be an emphasis on communication, collaboration, critical thinking, and creativity through project-based and inquiry-based learning. **[309920CW]**

## **The Power of Persuasion – Grades 10 – 12 – 1 Credit**

Students will explore persuasive techniques in the spoken, written, and graphic world. The course will present students with the skills necessary to distinguish between facts and opinions and provide tools to support their own reasoning. Student will take an in depth look at propaganda and other persuasive techniques to analyze their use in media, advertising, political races, and social media. Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate learning through projects and presentations. **[309921CW]**
