Topic: “Money Management”

Time Required: 35 minutes

Objective: Students will be able to identify ways they spend money and how to create a personal budget to save

School Core Values and Beliefs Expectations:

Materials Needed: Teens and Money Handout including “Young Spender’s Profile” Survey for Students Response

Procedure:

The students will read the packet and take the Young Spender’s Profile. As a whole group discuss and review the information in the package. Then complete the budget quiz. Evaluate the answers.

Discussion Questions:

- 1). Where do you think most teens spend their money?
- 2). Why do some teens have poor money management skills?

Closure:

Have students name one “tip” you would give to another teen on how to save money
