

**STUDENT ADVISORY ACTIVITY**  
**11th GRADE**  
**SESSION #20**

**Topic:** Time Capsule

**Time Required:** 35 minutes

**Objective:** Students will be able to consider the major changes and events that will happen in the next year before graduating Wilby.

**School Core Values & Beliefs Expectations Codes:**

**Activity Statement:** Students discuss the topic; students complete questionnaire to update time capsule. Every year, each advisory class will build a “Time Capsule” as a way to remember what happened during their time at Wilby. As juniors, you are beyond the half-way point for your time at Wilby, having completed both freshmen and sophomore years.

**Materials Needed:** Questionnaire attached

**Procedure:**

Discuss changes that have occurred during time at Wilby. Discuss how people and what’s “popular” change over time.

Complete attached questionnaire that will update time capsule now that 3 years have been completed at Wilby.

**Discussion Questions:**

Many things change during a student’s time at Wilby. Thus, as juniors, you are more knowledgeable in terms of how the high school functions. What changes have you seen since freshman year?

How have you changed since freshman year?

What favorite movies, types of music, and interests have changed since last year; since freshman year?

How have people changed? How has what is “popular” changed?

What would be interesting to look back upon when you are 25 years old?

**Closure:** Students will reflect upon their high school experiences and in the process of completing the time capsule, consider the major changes and events that will happen in the next year before graduation, and gain perspective on future goals.
