Every two years our district surveys students in grades 5, 7, 9, and 11 and alternative Education in order to learn about the problems that students face that are barriers to learning. The California Healthy Kids Survey assesses student health and behavior risks (such as drug use, violence and risk of depression). It also asks students for feedback on the school supports that research has identified as promoting school success (such as caring adults at school and academic motivation).

We use this information to put programs into place and to monitor their effectiveness. Monitoring progress and promoting youth well-being are essential parts of improving student academic performance and positive youth development.

It is Voluntary. Students who, with your permission, agree to participate do not have to answer any questions they do not want to answer, and may stop taking the survey at any time.

It is Anonymous. No names are recorded or attached to the survey forms or data. The results will be made available for analysis only under strict confidentiality controls.

Administration. The survey will be administered between November 1st and December 9th, 2021. It will take about one class period to complete (about 20 minutes) and will be administered in your child's Science (7th grade), PE or English (9th grade), and History (11th grade) class.

Potential Risks. There are no known risks of physical harm to your child. Risks of psychological or social harm are very small. None have been reported in 19 years of survey administration. In rare instances, some discomfort might be experienced from the questions. The school's counseling services will be available to answer any personal questions that may materialize.
