Projects/Essays

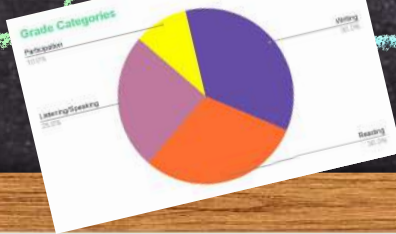
"Big Assignments" such as projects or essays will be weighted into the grade with a larger point assignment compared to regular daily assignments.

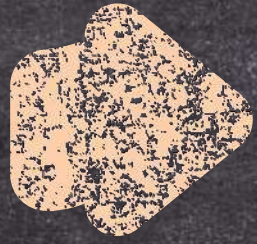
Grade Scale

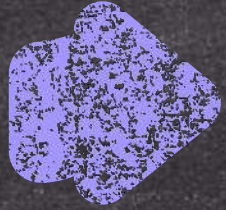


Plagiarism Policy
