Students who passed the FitnessGram in 9th grade CAN take PE over the summer between 10th and 11th grade. Students who did NOT pass the FitnessGram in 9th grade can NOT take PE over the summer. These students will need to take PE during their 11th grade year. These students can only take their STEM elective IF they choose to do 7 classes.
