All students will have the opportunity to meet individually with their eSTEM Counselor to review and finalize class selections starting February 25th through his/her eSTEM Language Arts 2 class. Please have this form completed by then.

Summer school courses are scheduled during this time. Summer school offers two sessions, with each session being the equivalent of one semester. Students will only be allowed to take PE if they passed the Fitness Test in 9th grade, per state and district requirements. Students can take an art class, US History, make up credits if needed, etc. if the course has space.
