2017-18 REGISTRATION

All parents/guardians must complete the **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION** process through the Aeries Parent Portal prior to attending **CAMPUS REGISTRATION**. Visit our school's Website @ http://www.tustin.k12.ca.us/foothill (Quick Links – Enrollment/Annual Registration) for more information about this new process. **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION will be accessible to parents beginning July 24.** New students to Foothill must enroll prior to **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION** @ http://www.tustin.k12.ca.us/foothill (Quick Links – Enrollment/Annual Registration). If you have recently moved, please bring in proof of residency to our office prior to ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION.

When **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION** is completed, you will be asked to print and sign the "Ticket to Register" (Data Confirmation Form). <u>This form will be required at campus registration</u>. There will be other forms posted within the **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION** process that you may be required to print and bring to **CAMPUS REGISTRATION** (these forms will be uploaded in the "Documents" section of this process). In order for the **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION** process to run smoothly, please have a current Aeries Parent Portal account (Site Links – Aeries Parent/Student Portal), and a current e-mail address. Also, be sure to sign up to receive our weekly Principal's Newsletter by clicking on "Join Our Mailing List" on our Website homepage.

CAMPUS REGISTRATION will occur August 8 through August 10, with make-up registration on August 14. If a student cannot attend his/her scheduled registration time, please make every effort to attend the make-up registration. If you are unable to attend both the scheduled and make-up registration times, contact the counseling office for an appointment to turn in forms and receive student schedules <u>after the registration days</u>. Please be advised that students who register late will not receive their new FHS ID card until make-up pictures are taken in September <u>and</u> may not be able to make needed revisions in schedules prior to the start of school.

During our **CAMPUS REGISTRATION**, students must return all required **ONLINE ANNUAL REGISTRATION** forms (see below). Students will have the opportunity to purchase ASB cards, yearbooks, student planners, PE clothes, *Knightlife*, Athletic Transportation, and have their pictures taken for the yearbook/ID cards. Parents may join the PTO, the Foothill Education Foundation (FEF), and various booster groups as well. If you wish, purchases can be made for most items through our online Webstore (www.FHSwebstore.com - a processing fee will be charged for online orders). As a reminder, during **CAMPUS REGISTRATION**, students will be sent.home if their required paperwork is incomplete or not signed by a parent/guardian.

Make-up Registration 7:30 -- 12:30 p.m. (Students who were out of town, have detentions, owe books/money)

As you shop for school clothes, please keep in mind that students must dress appropriately. TUSD Board Policy #5132 – In order to provide a safe learning environment free from major distractions, a school wide dress code has been developed and will be enforced. The dress code is as follows:

• Covered midriffs, cleavage, and backs

Tops with some type of sleeve or strap (no strapless or spaghetti strap attire)

• Completely covered undergarments

- No excessively short shorts or miniskirts
- Clothing free from offensive, gang related or otherwise inappropriate images, messages, or advertisements related but not limited to alcohol, tobacco or drugs

Violations in the above dress code will result in progressive discipline ranging from parent contact to Saturday School. Repeated violations may result in further disciplinary action. If students attend school dressed inappropriately, different attire can be provided. Parent support in encouraging students to dress appropriately is paramount.
