12th GRADE
SESSION # 20

Topic: High School vs. College vs. Workplace

Time Required: 35 minutes

Objective: Discuss with students the reality of college expectations vs. those of high school. Help students transition to life after high school with open eyes and a “heads up” awareness.

Activity Statement: You can share your own “reality hits” with the class to stimulate discussions. Many students as seniors have had siblings or friends who have gone through the experience. Encourage students to share what they know in the hope that others will benefit from being aware of the stumbling blocks to possibly avoid.

Materials Needed: Attached is comparison chart of the expectations in high school as opposed to what they are in college.

Procedure: Hand out comparison chart to the students, either read together or individually, and pick and choose the ones they would like to discuss. If you choose to discuss them one by one in order they are charted you may not have sufficient time.

Discussion Questions: Ask individual students to pick one topic, read it aloud, and ask the class to comment on, or question what is written.

Closure: Address any concerns regarding discussion
