STUDENT ADVISORY ACTIVITY 12th GRADE SESSION #21

Topic: Senior <u>Memory Puzzle</u>

Time Required: 35 minutes

Objective: Each advisory student will be making a puzzle to be displayed the last couple weeks of school in the Cafeteria. Each student (and teacher) will decorate one puzzle piece (example attached).

Procedure: Begin by orienting your puzzle piece correctly-you don't want your pictures to be upside down! Please write your name (first and last) on the front of the puzzle piece. Now fill the remaining space on the puzzle piece with drawings, words, and/or cut outs of how you would like Wilby High School to remember you. All the information must be school appropriate.

Discussion Questions:	Show and tell.
	Discuss what students put on their puzzle pieces.
	What is the significance of each picture of words?

Closure: Collect the completed puzzle pieces at the end of the advisory and place them in the large manila envelope that was provided for you and place it in the office.
