Treasure's Report	 \$5,201.69 BASE Account \$9074.94 General Account \$14,300.76 Total Waiting for refund from first bus company. Need to pay second bus company. Also owe part of the buses from state as Boosters did not approve the full amount of the request for the buses. Additionally the amount due to the accountant is higher than expected. If all expenses are correct we have a balance of \$289.94. Also owe Roper on top of this amount. \$4,500 (estimated) are still owed by students.
