Panorama Survey

- **What:** Measures Students' perceptions of School Climate
- **When:** Annually, each Spring
- **Who:**
 - 3rd-5th Grade Students
 - 9th-12th Grade Students
 - Families
- **Why:** Research shows that school climate strongly influences students' motivation to learn and improve academic achievement. When school members feel safe, valued, cared for, respected, and engaged, learning increases.

How the results/data is used:

1. MUSD Schools use result to set annual goals as part of their schoolwide Strategic Action Plans.
2. District reports to CA School Dashboard each year under **Local Climate Survey**.

Access to a Broad Course of Study

- CA Legislature & CDE: School Climate Index, is strongly related to state Academic Performance Index (API) scores.
- **February 2021, CA SB 699** School climate: Require the CA Department of Education, on or before October 1, 2022, to adopt a statewide school climate survey indicator.
- MUSD has utilized the *Panorama Survey* annually since 2015/16.
- 2021/22: Sites wanted a mid-year progress of **School Climate**.

2021/22 – Mid-Year Progress

1. MUSD has utilized the *Panorama Survey* annually since 2015/16.
 - a. 2015-16: 6th-10th graders and families
 - b. 2016-17: 5th-10th graders and families
 - c. 2017-18: 5th-10th graders and families
 - d. 2018-19: 5th-10th graders and families
 - e. 2019-20: families only due to school shut-down.
 - f. 2020-21: 3rd-12th graders and families
2. 2021/22: Sites wanted a mid-year progress.

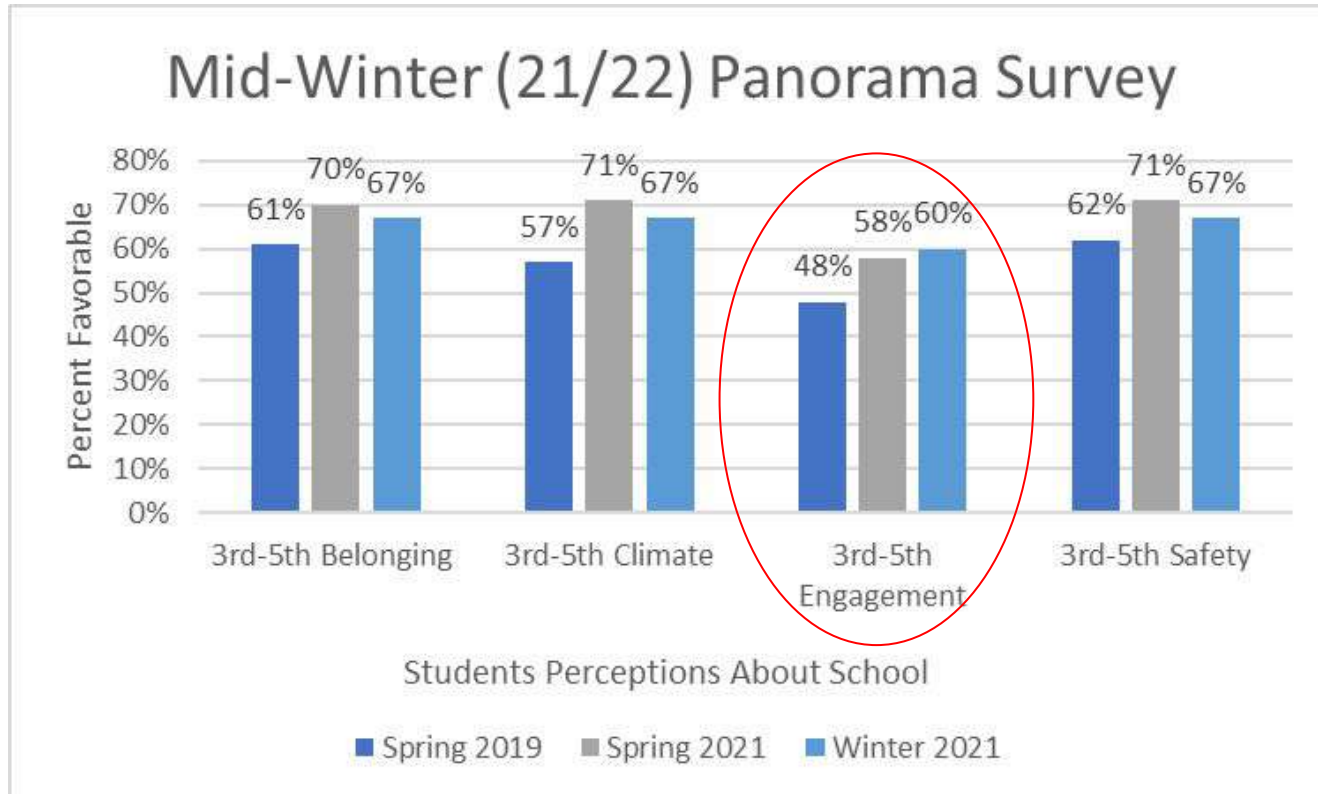

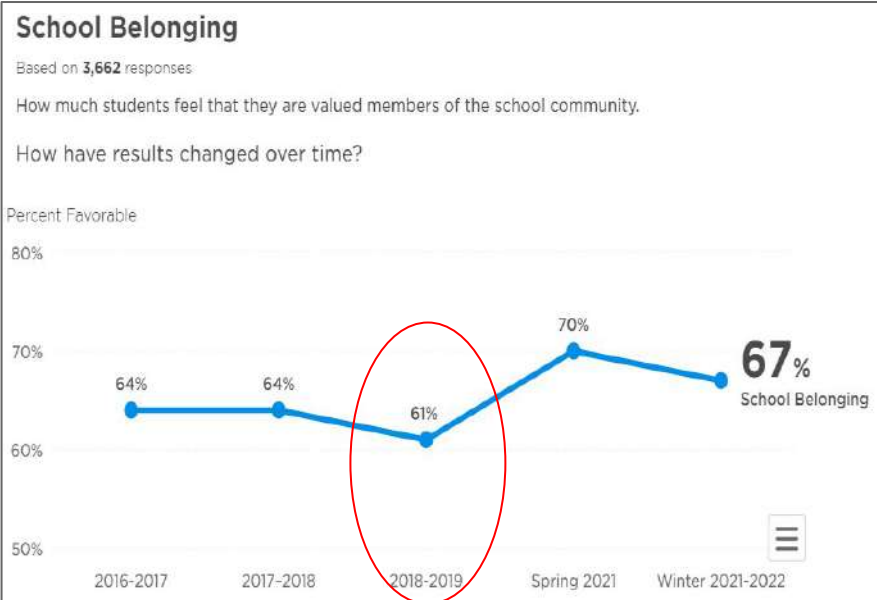

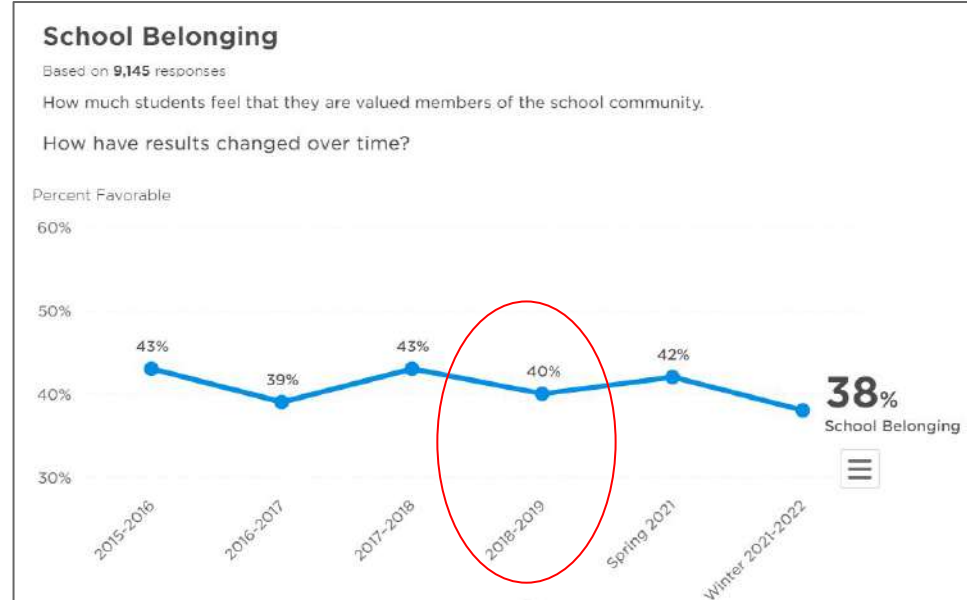

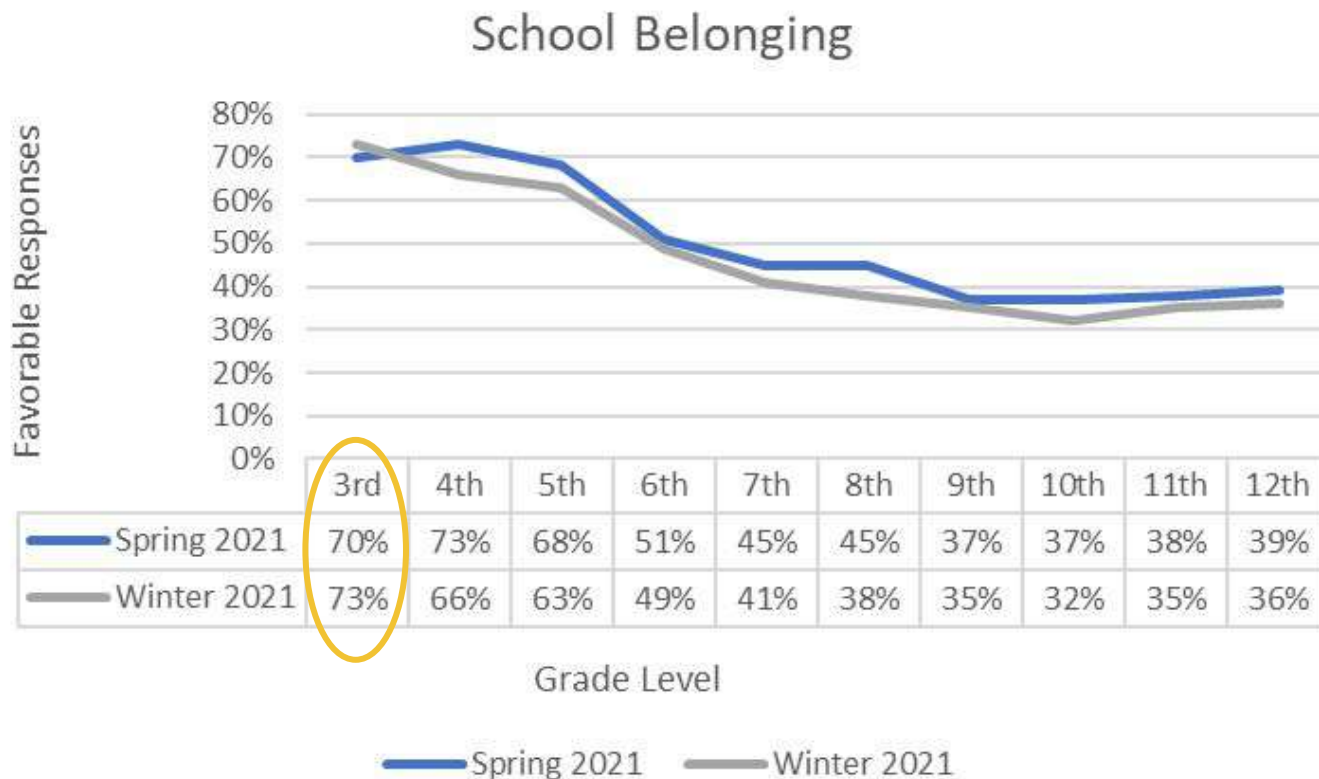

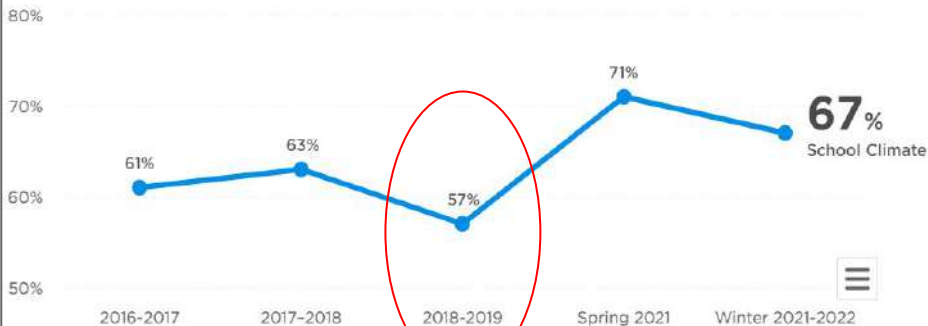

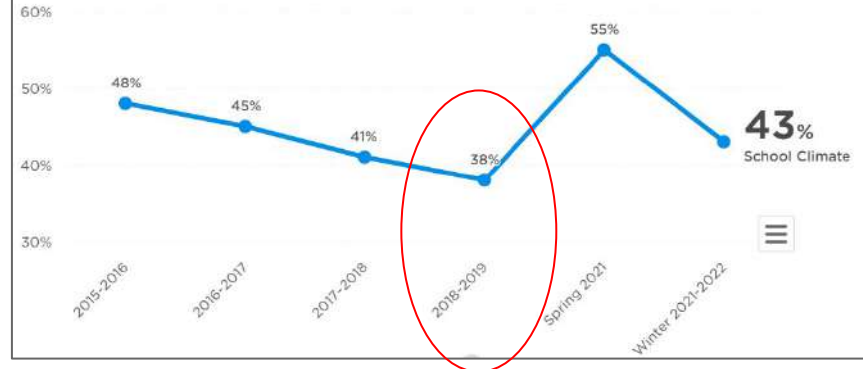

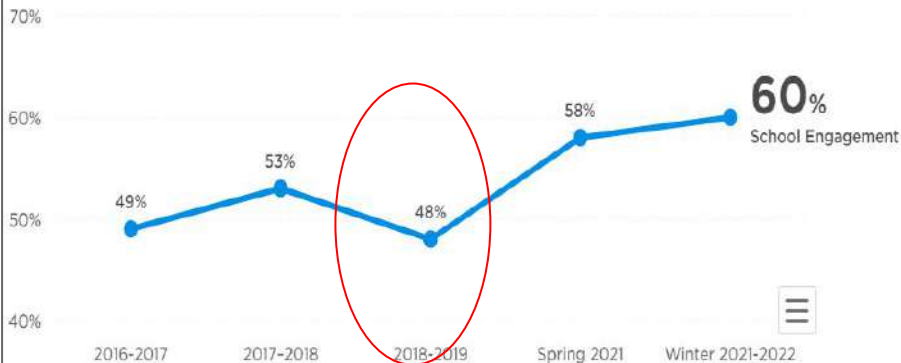

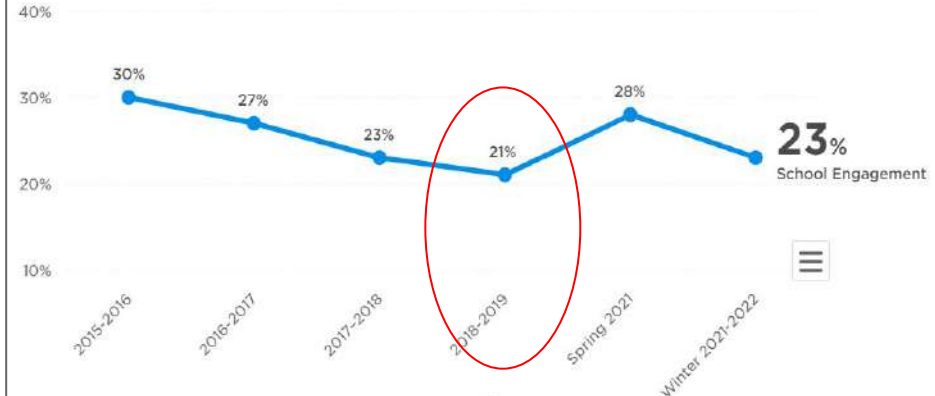

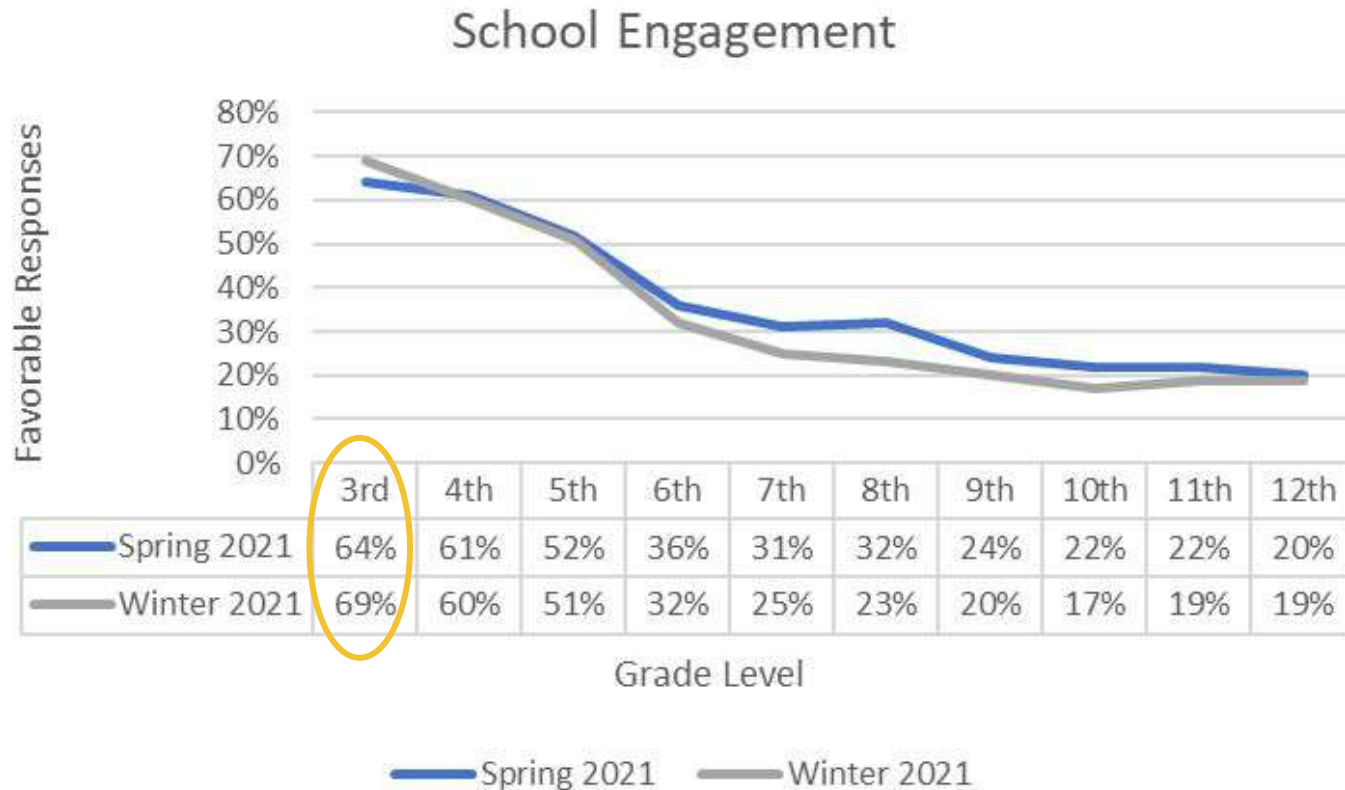

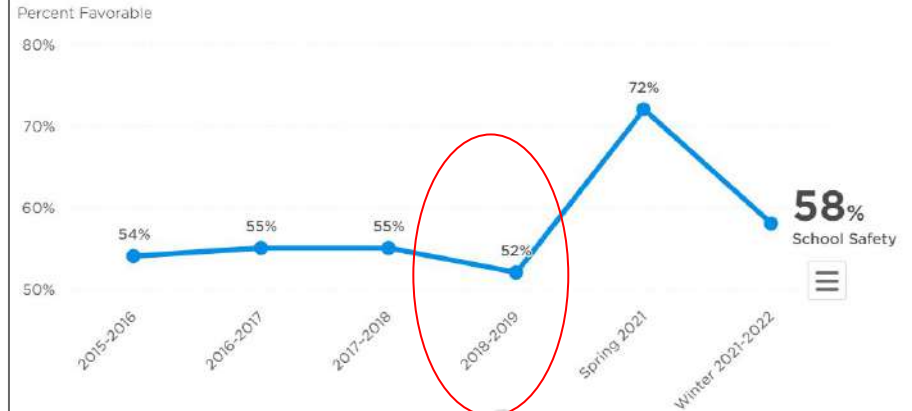
