Half of this population are early adult students who are having challenges organizing their personal and educational tasks. Overall classroom population is very good, but Independent Students population are driving down the attendance rates. Mr. Corbin mentioned the importance of the classroom teachers at Golden Gate for going above and beyond to help students.
