- > Select a minimum of 6 classes (if selecting a 0-Period, you may have up to 7 classes)
- > English, Government, and Economics are required senior year courses.

ENGLISH (Required):

- English 12 CP
- ERWC 12 (Expository Reading & Writing Course): recommended for students looking to improve writing skills in preparation for college level writing. Equivalent to English 12 CP, but more writing focused.
- AP English 12

SOCIAL STUDIES (Required):

- **US Government** (1 semester) & **Economics** (1 semester)
- AP Comp. Gov. / AP US Gov. (Yearlong)
- AP Economics (Yearlong)

MATH (**Recommended**): completing Int. Math 3 is the minimum graduation requirement for math, but a 4th year of math is *highly recommended* if applying to 4-year colleges next year.
