Students who meet the criteria listed on PAGE 2 will be recommended for a summer school class(es) by their school site Counselor. These students will be mailed an invitation to register for summer school via US Mail on April 12th. The invitation will include registration instructions and registration dates.

Summer School is a *remediation program*. Students must meet the criteria listed and receive a Counselor referral in order to qualify. Every effort is made to accommodate all students, but if courses are full students will be placed according to the priority listing on PAGE 2.



SUMMER SCHOOL

CRITERIA: LISTED IN ORDER OF PRIORITY

1.	12 th grade students for 2018-2019 school year who need to make up an “F” in one of the courses offered, are deficient in credits, or are below the 2.0 GPA requirement for graduation.
2.	11 th grade students for the 2018-2019 school year who need to make up an “F” in one of the courses offered, are deficient in credits or are below the 2.0 GPA requirement for graduation.
3.	12 th and 11 th grade students for the 2018-2019 school year who need to make up a “D” in one of the courses offered in order to meet the 2.0 GPA requirement for graduation.
4.	10 th and 9 th grade students for the 2018-2019 school year who need to make up an “F” in one of the courses offered and are deficient in credits.
5.	10 th grade students for the 2018-2019 school year who have an impacted schedule due to enrollment in an academy, leadership or other specialized program. Students must have 2 years of successful enrollment in order to qualify.

Special Education/Extended School Year Registration: Packets for elementary, junior high, and high school students will be mailed to the student's home in April. For additional information regarding ESY, please contact Special Education at (909) 628-1201 extension 1400.

Attendance: Students must be present on the first day of each session or they will be dropped from the summer program. Summer school requires intensive content instruction in a relatively short time period and consistent class attendance is required. Students will be dropped from their course if they miss more than 6 instructional hours per session, including tardies. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

Nutrition: Summer school breakfast will be available during the nutrition break for \$1.25. If your child is currently on the Free or Reduced meal program, he/she is still eligible for free meals or reduced meals for .25 cents. You may reapply for the Free or Reduced Meal program online or in person all year long. Please note: All families must reapply every year after July 1, 2019. Transportation: With the exception of some students enrolled in the Extended School Year Program (ESY) transportation will NOT be provided. ESY students will receive additional information from Special Education.
