### Registration period for Traditional High School Summer School: March 1 – April 30, 2021

Students who were recommended by their High School Counselor to take Traditional Summer School class(es) will be enrolled, providing they meet the criteria listed above. <u>Enrolled students will receive an email at their</u> <u>School District (Outlook) email address prior to the start of Traditional Summer School</u>.

Important: In the event that classes are overenrolled, priority will be given to current 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who need course credit(s) to meet graduation and/or college entrance requirements.

### **Course Enrollment Criteria:**

- Traditional Summer School is offered to current 9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade students for the 2020-2021 school year who need to make up a D or F in any of the courses offered above in order to meet graduation and/or college entrance requirements.
- 2) Courses with an \* are available to rising 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who have had an impacted schedule during their 9<sup>th</sup> and/or 10<sup>th</sup> grade year. <u>Note</u>: An impacted schedule is defined as a schedule with a full 6 period school day that prioritizes academic core classes required for high school graduation but does not have the flexibility or space to include course(s) denoted by the asterisk.
- 3) Courses with **BV** next to course title are available to current 12<sup>th</sup> grade students <u>ONLY</u>.
- 4) Art Fundamental is offered at Ayala High School ONLY.

Attendance for the Traditional High School Program: Students must make contact with their teachers at the start of each summer school session or they may be dropped from the summer program. Summer school requires intensive content instruction in a period of time and consistent class work is required.
