


INTERSEGMENTAL GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM (IGETC)


COLLEGE FRESHMAN


Students who complete this academy will apply as college freshmen & will have earned a <u>GE certificate</u> from Cerritos College. The university may require additional GE courses based on university requirements/major.

TRANSFER STUDENT

Students who wish to apply as transfer students must attend at least one semester of community college after high school graduation. <u>IGETC Certification</u> only applies to transfer students
