Dual Credit & AP Courses

WHS offers 16 Dual Credit Courses and 16 Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

Dual Credit Course - Drury

- Cost: \$70 per credit hour
- Students will enroll in class and fill out FERPA. Parents will be sent an email to give permission for their child to enroll in a dual credit course.
- Due to varying university policies on awarding/accepting credits, we highly recommend that students check with their future postsecondary school to verify what transfer credits will be accepted and what type of credits they will award.

Dual Credit Course - MSU

- AP Spanish Only
- Cost: \$70 per credit hour
- Students will enroll in class and fill out FERPA.
 Parents will be sent an email to give permission for their child to enroll in a dual credit course.
- Due to varying university policies on awarding/accepting credits, we highly recommend that students check with their future postsecondary school to verify what transfer credits will be accepted and what type of credits they will award.

Advanced Placement Courses (AP)

- Students commit to staying in AP courses all year.
- AP courses cannot be dropped.
- November 15: Deadline for the AP Coordinator to submit the exam order.
- Exams may be canceled after this date, but \$40 will be charged per exam.
- ALL students enrolled in an AP course are expected to take the AP exam. Students that earn a qualifying score on an AP exam receive \$100 per qualifying score!
- Students can potentially earn college credit with a qualifying score. Due to varying university policies on awarding/accepting credits, we highly recommend that students check with their future postsecondary school to verify what transfer credits will be accepted and


