

Ruben S. Ayala High School CAASPP Testing Information and Schedule

Dear Bulldog Families,

Ayala will begin CAASPP State Testing on April 11th. All students in 11th grade will participate in testing. Let's work collaboratively to encourage our students to do their best!

Students will receive Cords to wear at graduation if they earn a Proficient or Exceed on the CAASPP testing:

- Proficient/Exceed in One Subject will receive a RED Cord
- Proficient/Exceed in TWO Subjects will receive a RED and BLACK Cord
- Proficient/Exceed in ALL THREE Subjects will receive a RED, WHITE, and BLACK Cord

In order to accommodate all students, we will have a Block Schedule on the following days:

- Tuesday, April 11th and Wednesday, April 12th
- Tuesday, April 18th and Wednesday, April 19th
- Tuesday, April 25th and Wednesday, April 26th

Students will be testing during the highlighted periods.

Students in 9th, 10th, and 12th grade will be taking the practice CAASPP assessments while our 11th graders are testing and/or working on teacher assigned lessons/projects.

We ask that during the testing days students do the following:

- Go to bed early and get a good night's rest
- Eat a healthy breakfast (Breakfast available at school 8am-8:30am)
- Arrive to school On Time, Students will not be allowed into their classroom tardy
- Students can not be checked out early during their testing block
- Bring Chromebook fully charged to school with charger
- Positive Self talk; "You Got This" "Do Your Best"
- No Phones or Smart Watches allowed during the test, everything is to be turned off inside of the backpack.

- Take their time and reread all the questions
- Check their work

As a school community, homework will be limited on testing days for our 11th graders to ensure they go to bed early and arrive at school on time! We want to make sure they are focused and know the importance of them trying their best.
