- Complete 35 hours of Community Service



#### **Common Answers to Questions**

- For Seniors: Peer tutors and shortened days are requested once the school year starts. You MUST select 6 classes plus alternates by March 8th.
- Use your CCGI results to help choose your classes that align with your interests and career goals.
- Classes will automatically "Save"

#### Example Schedule: **10th Grade**

- English 2 or English 2 Honors
- Chemistry or Chemistry Honors or Medical Chemistry
- Math
- Foreign Language
- World History or AP World History
- PE (Or Pathway Course; for example, AVID, GEARS, or Band)
  - Band Students: must do Summer Band AND Marching Band for PE Credit
- \* ALL Classes are YEAR long, NO class change will be done

## Example Schedule: 11<sup>th</sup> Grade

- English 3 or AP English Language
- Physics or other science choices
- Math
- Foreign Language
- US History or AP US History
- Elective (Or Pathway Course; for example, AVID, GEARS, Band or Bio Med)

## Example Schedule: 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Expository Reading & Writing (ERWC), Creative Writing, African American Literature or AP English Literature
- Anatomy or other science choices (optional in selecting a Science)
- Math (pending prior grade in math class)
- Foreign Language
- Government & Economics or AP Govt and Economics
- Elective (Or Pathway Course; for example, AVID, GEARS, Band or Bio Med)

\* ALL Classes are YEAR long, NO class change will be done

#### LMC classes on PHS campus

- If accepted, you will NOT have a 5th or 6th period though PHS
- Space is limited, you may NOT get in to the class.
- Please let your Counselor or the College and Career Center know of your interest in the program.

(you MUST choose 2 alternates for the LMC class because it is space available. If all steps are completed, we will drop your electives)


## Steps to select classes on Aeries

#### Video Steps to Select Courses

- Log into Parent Portal account or Student Portal account
- Select: Student name and make sure the school is Pittsburg High School
- Select: Classes > Course request entry



- You will see courses your counselor chose for you
- Complete/revise your course requests
- Select: Course title > use drop down menu to choose > Search



## Steps to select classes on Aeries


Click
