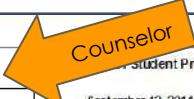

Example Schedule: 10th Grade

- English 2 or English 2 Honors
 - Chemistry or Chemistry Honors or Medical Chemistry
 - Math
 - Foreign Language
 - World History or AP World History
 - PE (Or Pathway Course; for example, AVID, GEARS, or Band)
 - Band Students: must do Summer Band AND Marching Band for PE Credit

- Physics or other science choices

Example Schedule: 12th Grade

- Expository Reading & Writing (ERWC), Creative Writing, African American Literature or AP English Literature
- Anatomy or other science choices (optional in selecting a Science)
- Math (pending prior grade in math class)
- Foreign Language
- Government & Economics or AP Govt and Economics
- Elective (Or Pathway Course; for example, AVID, GEARS, Band or Bio Med)

LMC classes on PHS campus

(you **MUST choose 2 alternates** for the LMC class because it is space available. If all steps are completed, we will drop your electives)

Video Steps to Select Courses

- **Log into** Parent Portal account or Student Portal account
- **Select:** Student name and make sure the school is Pittsburg High School
- **Select:** Classes > Course request entry



- You will see courses your counselor chose for you
- Complete/revise your course requests
- **Select:** Course title > use drop down menu to choose > Search
