


CREDIT RECOVERY

PROGRAM MODELS

Traditional Model

- Students attend class every Tuesday and Thursday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.
- Curriculum is offered in packet format
- Courses meet A-G requirments

Virtual Model

- Teacher support is available online on Tuesday and Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
- Curriculum offered in online format
- Courses meet A-G requirments

**The Virtual Model is HIGHLY recommended for NCAA candidates

PROGRAM POLICIES

- Students may recover a maximum of ten (10) credits per semester.
- It is the school site's responsibility to notify parents and provide program guidelines when a student has been recommended for a credit recovery program.
- Students enrolled in a credit recovery program are required to maintain a notebook as part of their course work.
- Students are expected to follow the District Behavior Code and Technology Agreement while participating in a credit recovery course, or they may be dropped from the program.
- Under no circumstances can a student be dually enrolled in course(s) listed in their regular school schedule and credit recovery.

ATTENDANCE CRITERIA

Attendance will be reported on a weekly basis to the student site counselors. It is the responsibility of each school site to follow-up with students who have irregular attendance.

Traditional Format

Students are allowed 2 absences and will be dropped on the 3rd absence, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Students tardy for 15 minutes or more will receive a half day absence.

Students with poor attendance and unsatisfactory work habits at the 2 week session mark, will receive a concern check from the teacher by email or telephone.

Virtual Format

Students who do not log into the program within a 5-day period will receive a concern check from the teacher by email or telephone.

Students who do not log into the program for a 10-day period WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE PROGRAM.

Student attendance is monitored by the amount of time working within the online platform and the quality of work submitted.

GRADING PROCEDURES

- Students who earn an "F" grade in Credit Recovery will receive an "NG" (no grade); this will not be posted onto the student's transcript.
- The Alternative Education Center is responsible for posting credit recovery grades to student transcripts.
- Grades will be posted to student transcript, no later than 10 days after a session has ended.
- An original grade of "D" or "F" will be tagged with a repeat code if the credit recovery grade is a "C" or higher.
