Summer school courses are scheduled during this time. Summer school offers two sessions, with each session being the equivalent of one semester. Students will only be allowed to take PE if they passed the Fitness Test in 9th grade, per state and district requirements. Students can take an art class, US History, make up credits if needed, etc. if the course has space. The type of art class will depend on staffing determined at a later time.
