11th and 12th grade students will begin state testing.

12th grade students will take the CAST (California Science Test) the week before spring break in their Gov/Econ classes. After returning to from spring break, 11th grade students will complete the CAST, and the CAASPP in English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics. 11th grade students will complete the CAST the week of 4/4 in their history class. The week of 4/11, 11th grade students will complete their English Language Arts exam in the ELA class. Finally, during the week of 4/18, all 11th grade students will complete the math exam in a preassigned math classroom.

During testing, it is essential for students to bring their school device charged to school each day. Personal devices will not be used during testing. If a student does not have a school device, one will be provided for them during testing.

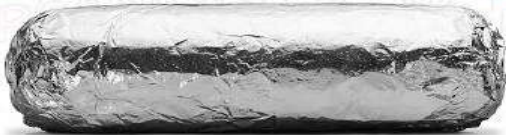

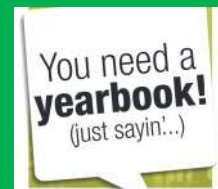

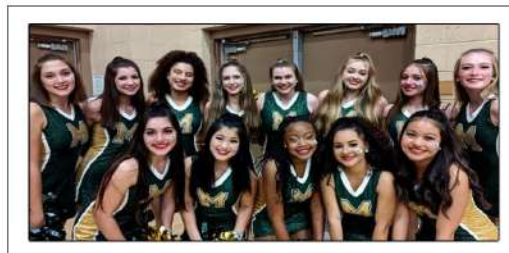
