Course Enrollment Criteria:

- 1) Traditional Distance Learning (Online) Summer School is offered to current 9th 12th grade students for the 2019-2020 school year who need to make up a D or F in any of the courses offered above in order to meet graduation and/or college entrance requirements.
- 2) Pathway courses (P) are available to rising 11th grade students who have had an impacted schedule during their 9th and/or 10th grade year.

Registration period for Traditional Distance Learning (Online) Summer School: January 21 – March 19, 2020

Students who were recommended by their School Counselor to take Traditional Distance Learning (Online)

Summer School class(es) will be enrolled, providing they meet the criteria listed above. Enrolled students will receive an email at their District (school) email address which will include their login credentials required to access online summer school classes prior to the start of Traditional Distance Learning (Online) Summer School.

Important: In the event that classes are overenrolled, priority will be given to current 12th and 11th grade students who need course credit(s) to meet graduation and/or college entrance requirements. This includes all Pathway courses (P) listed above.

Special Education/Extended School Year (ESY): Extended School Year (ESY) for elementary students will continue in a distance learning (online) format. ESY for junior high school students will continue in a distance learning (online) format. ESY for high school students will continue in a distance learning (online) format. Attendance for the Traditional Distance Learning (Online) High School Program: Students must be present on the first day of each session or they will be dropped from the summer program. Summer school requires intensive content instruction in a relatively short time period and consistent class attendance is required. Students will be dropped from their course if they miss more than six (6) instructional hours per session.
