Criteria:

- ❖ Summer School is offered to current 9th – 12th grade students for the 2019-2020 school year who need to make up a D or F in any of the courses offered in order to meet graduation and/or college requirements.
- ❖ Pathway Courses (P) are available to incoming 11th grade students who have had an impacted schedule during their 9th and/or 10th grade year.
- ❖ Art Fundamentals will be offered at Chino Hills High ONLY.

Registration:

January 21 – March 19, 2020

Interested students must meet with their School Site Guidance Counselor to register for courses and complete a registration form.

Important: In the event classes are over enrolled priority is given to current 12th and 11th grade students who need course credit(s) to meet graduation and/or college requirements, this includes all Pathway courses.

Special Education/Extended School Year Registration: Packets for elementary, junior high, and high school students will be mailed to the student's home in April. For additional information regarding the Extended School Year Program (ESY), please contact Special Education at (909) 628-1201 extension 1400.

Attendance: Students must be present on the first day of each session or they will be dropped from the summer program. Summer school requires intensive content instruction in a relatively short time period and consistent class attendance is required. Students will be dropped from their course if they miss more than 6 instructional hours per session, including tardies. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

Nutrition: Summer school breakfast will be available during the nutrition break for \$1.25. If your child is currently on the Free or Reduced meal program, he/she is still eligible for free meals or reduced meals for .25 cents. You may reapply for the Free or Reduced Meal program online or in person all year long. Please note: All families must reapply every year after July 1, 2020. Transportation: With the exception of some students enrolled in the Extended School Year Program (ESY) transportation will NOT be provided. ESY students will receive additional information from Special Education.
