## Separation Agreement – Alabaster City Schools – 2013-2014 School Year and Thereafter

After the first year (2013-2014 SY), the point of demarcation is the end of 5<sup>th</sup> Grade School Year and Kindergarten.

- When students that live outside the city limits (Alabaster City Schools (ACS) attendance zone) exit the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade, they will enroll in specific Shelby County Schools (SCS) attendance zones.
- When Kindergarten students that live outside the ACS attendance zone enroll for the first time, they will register in their specific SCS attendance zone.
- All students in Grades 6-12 enrolled in Alabaster Schools who live outside the ACS attendance zone will remain in their schools until graduation.
- All students in Grades K-5 enrolled in Alabaster Schools who live outside ACS attendance zone will remain in their schools until they exit the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade.
- Students enrolled in the Shelby County College and Career Center (formerly known as the School of Technology SOT) from the ACS attendance zone will remain until their program is completed at the end of their 12<sup>th</sup> Grade year.
- Students enrolled in Linda Nolen Learning Center will follow the same transition schedule as the other students.
