Class W License – Performing Arts Facility

- (23) A Class W License shall authorize the sale at retail of alcoholic liquor to patrons of a performing arts facility not more than one hour before the start of the theatrical performance and no later than one-half (1/2) hour before the end of a theatrical performance.
  - a. Such sale and delivery shall be confined to the lobby or foyer of the licensed premises.
  - b. Such area shall be without seating and shall be fully illuminated. There may be "tall top tables", but no chairs in the bar area.
  - c. Alcoholic liquor may be consumed within the seating area of the performance area.
  - d. Alcoholic liquor shall be sold and served from a customer bar only. Beer shall be served by the glass or bottle only, having a capacity of not more than twelve (12) ounces. Other alcoholic liquor shall be served by the glass only, and such vessel shall have a capacity of not more than six (6) ounces.

The annual fee for a class W license shall be five hundred dollars (\$750.00).
