- All failed classes need to be taken online unless it is a math course then you can repeat that course here.



Course Selection Process Tips

- Click on Course Registration
- To see ALL courses: Click Course search, then "GO"
- To request specific courses, click on the course, and click "request this course"
- Be sure to register for at least 32/32 requested units (we recommend requesting more!)


