What We're learning

Math

We will continue to work on addition and subtraction stories within 10. We will relate pictures and objects to equations to solve math problems. We will continue to represent teen numbers as ten ones and some more ones. We will also be working on positional words; above, under, next to, etc.

Language Arts

In Wonders we will read some stories that will take us for a tour across the country. Through these stories we will work on identify characters, setting and sequence of events (first, next, then and last). We will continue to sound out CVC words (consonant-vowel-consonant). We will also be working on drawing with detail and writing to respond to the text.

Fundations

In Foundations we will work on identifying trick words (sight words). These are words your child will need to recognize automatically. Please make flashcards of these words to practice at home; a, and, are, as, be, by, do, for, from, has, he, I, is, me, my, of, one, or, she, the, they, to, was, we, you.

Science Our topic will be plants and animals.
