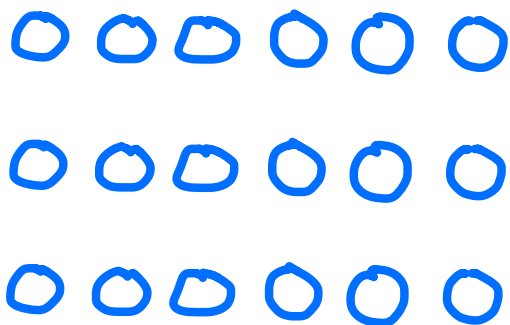


a. There are 4 rows of stars. How many stars are in each row? 3
