## Carrington School Changes for the 2014-2015 School Year

- **Seventh Grade** Seventh graders, including 60% who have been at Carrington School since kindergarten, will expand their studies. Approximately 25 7<sup>th</sup> graders will build writing abilities through the Middle School Writing Project at Education Connection in Litchfield. Carrington's motivated writers will meet with students from four other school districts six times in the school year.
- **Spanish Language** Teacher of Spanish Tara Allen will join the Carrington faculty this year, and teach the language during the first semester. Children of the younger grades will be taught the phonemes (the sounds) of Spanish, and learn some simple vocabulary of Spanish. Ms. Allen will then move to Gilmartin School for the second semester.
- **Technical Education** Last year Technical Education teacher Theresa Foulds taught at Carrington two afternoons per week. This year Ms. Foulds will teach every day in the second semester at Carrington.
- **Science Program** Carrington School's two main parts to its Science program. Mrs. Ford is the teacher of Science for the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and will teach younger students in collaboration with other teachers. Second, Carrington teachers of grades 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 are engaged in a professional development program for Science teaching. Students will observe, analyze, and record science phenomena.
- **Teachers New to Carrington** Teachers new to Carrington include Nancy Silva and Stephen Carousella 5<sup>th</sup> grade, Cody Fusco, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Alex Mollengarden, 4th grade. Miss Pentlicki though not new to Carrington, this year will teach 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. For 7<sup>th</sup> grade, teachers are: Marnie Ford Science, Ivan Hernandez Math, Jodi Sarlo Language Arts, and James R. Thomas Social Studies. Bob Shagensky is our new Math Coach, shared with Bunker Hill School.
