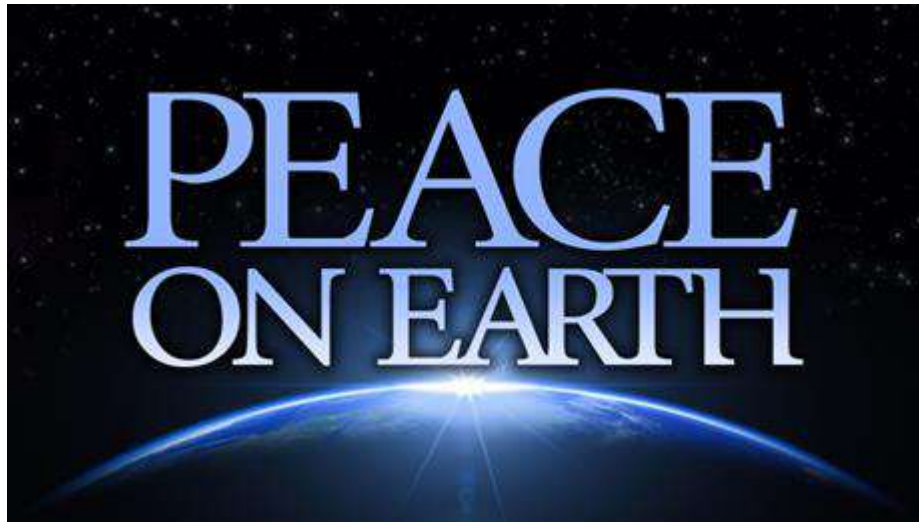

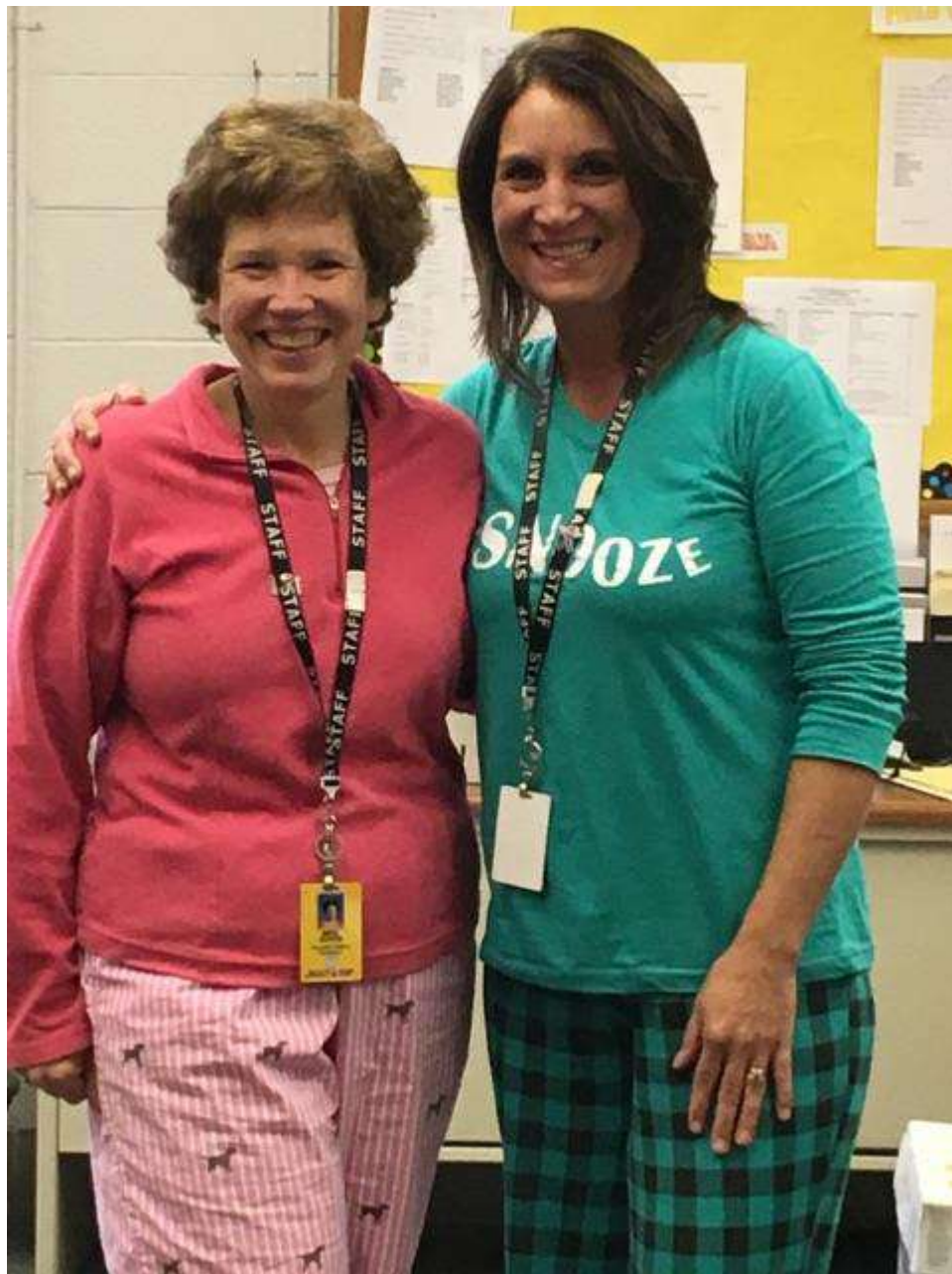
Tolland High School Musicians Participate in Eastern Region Music Festival

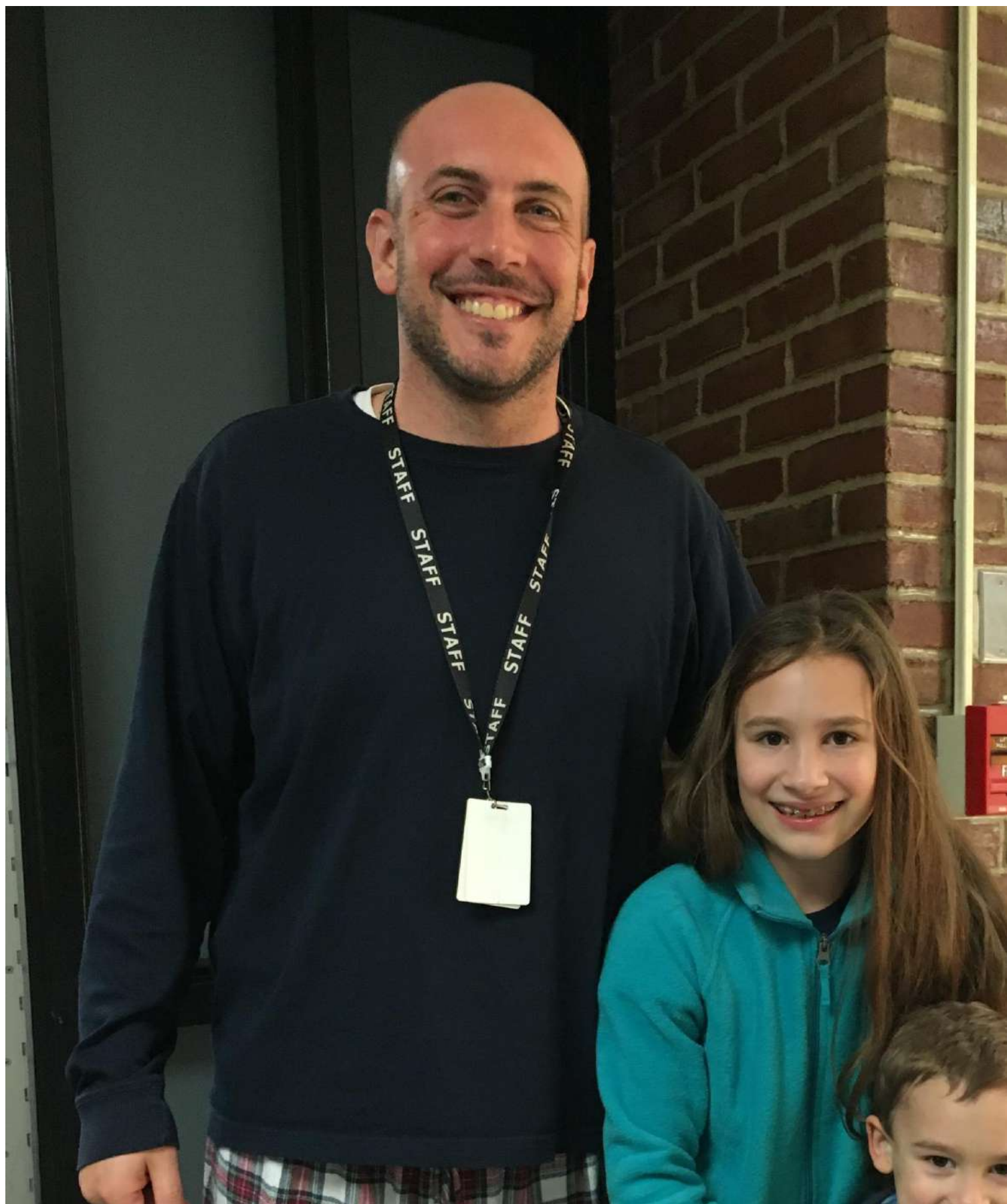

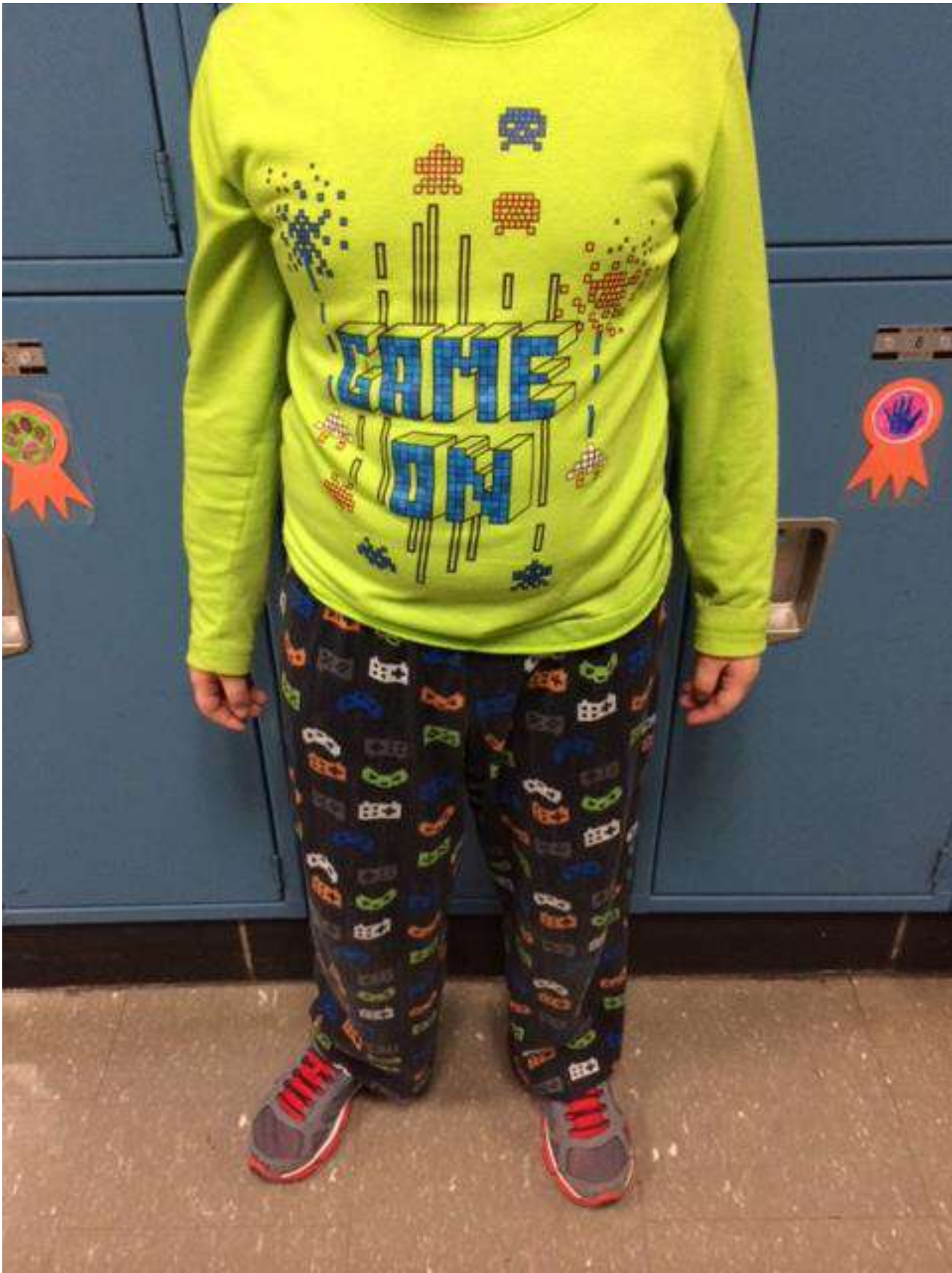
