2016 - 2017 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

<u>Documents required for Kindergarten registration:</u>

- o Birth Certificate or Passport
- Current Physical Examination and/or an appointment for a Physical Exam if current physical expires later in the year
- Immunization Records and Lead Test Results
- o Legal Proof of Guardianship (if child is not your parental born child)
- Proof of Residency (recent utility bill, Natural Gas, Electric or Cable bill, current lease, rent receipt, letter from relative or person with whom you are residing and one of their bills)
- Copy of current IEP, if your child is receiving Special Education Services

All Kindergarten registrations will be processed **ONLY** at the Waterbury Family Intake Center at One Jefferson Square on the first floor.

Registration hours are from 8:15 am until 2:45 pm, April 4^{th} & 5^{th} for children who will be 5 years old on or before January 1, 2017.

If the child speaks a language other than English, then the child ${f MUST}$ be present at the time of registration.

If your child is scheduled for immunizations or physicals after the listed registration date, it does not prohibit you from registering your child.

Please note: Normal school registrations, including kindergarten, will continue to be completed during regular business hours throughout the year.
