UPDATE 2 FOR SUMMER – 8/11/2017

BUDGET and BEGINNING OF SCHOOL UPDATE

The State of Connecticut has not yet passed a budget. As a result, the Town Council and Board of Education are working to find the best way forward. The reductions for Tolland's education system in terms of State "Educational Cost Sharing" or "ECS" funding could be as extreme as 8.2 million (out of about 10.7 million). Other scenarios explored by the Town Council involved a 3-million-dollar reduction below the FY16-17 budget level for the Board of Education (3.7-million-dollar reduction to the Town overall).

The current Revised Budget Plan provided by the Town Manager on August 2, 2017 recommends some use of the fund balance, and Board of Education funds among other reductions, that makes the reduction to the Board of Education budget about \$993,340 below the FY16-17 BOE budget.

Total reductions proposed at this time represent \$1,835,352 from the Board of Education Adopted budget on February 8, 2017. In the Board of Education meeting on Wednesday, August 11th the BOE synthesized and forwarded to the Town Manager and Town Council

a one-page document recommending some changes to the Town Manager's Revised Budget Plan of August 2, 2017.

The district has currently "reduced in force" (laid off, eliminated positions, not rehired, etc.) 13 positions with potentially more necessary. Depending on the decisions in the next few days and weeks additional administration and/or teacher positions could be eliminated to reach budget requirements. The district has also eliminated many non-personnel items.

If the proposed referendum in the Town Manager's Revised Budget Plan of 8-2-2017 does not pass at referendum, and/or the BOE reduction becomes larger, the number of positions lost in the district could raise to 30 or 40 or higher. Such reductions would mean the elimination of any district funding of Interscholastic Athletics, Middle School World Language, class sizes larger than has been seen in decades, counselor loads increased significantly, gravely impacted supports for struggling students in general education (SRBI/RTI), elimination of administrators beyond the Director of Curriculum such as Assistant Principals at BGP and possibly TIS, and more. It would change the face of education in Tolland.
