





Much ado about MILK:

From time to time the question arises, can the children be offered something *other* than milk with their lunch. While the question is an easy and straightforward one, like many things in life, there are some elements of complexity to the answer. In short, YES, you can, however it is federal regulation of the national school lunch program that milk is offered with lunch, or a nutritionally equivalent option is offered where allergies are a consideration. Only a "nutritional equal" substitute to milk may be offered in place of the milk component, unless there is approved medical documentation. Please see the Milk Substitution Letter. We will also give children a glass if they wish to get water from the water fountain.
