

Music Booster Senior Scholarship

The Music Booster Club will award scholarship(s) to Fort Morgan High School male or female graduate(s). The scholarship is non-renewable and may be used in-state or out-of-state at any accredited college, university, junior or community college, technical or business school. The money is payable to the specific institution. The number of awards and the amount may vary from year to year depending on monies available.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

1. Scholarship applications must be returned to the counseling center on or before **April 7, 2017. No late applications will be accepted.**
2. A completed application must include the following:
 - a. Application form
 - b. Essay describing how you became involved in music, how music has been an important part of your life and what role you hope music will play in your future.
 - c. Two completed personal reference letters:
 1. one from school faculty
 2. one from a community member (i.e: doctor, family friend, minister, employer, etc.)
 - d. Current high school transcript (does not need to be an official transcript)
3. The Music Booster Club scholarship committee will evaluate all applications.

Scholarship applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Involvement in the music program
- Completed Essay
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- Academic aspiration

YOU MUST BE A CURRENT STUDENT IN THE MUSIC DEPARTMENT TO APPLY. PURSUING A MUSIC MAJOR IS NOT REQUIRED.
