



APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR THE WILLIAMS FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship program provides assistance to students planning to major in a medical career or allied health *patient care* career, *such as physician, dentist, RN, lab tech, OT/PT/ST/RT, physician's assistant, radiology technician, dental hygienist, pharmacist and almost any other therapy field*, Colorado institutions only. Amounts range from \$5,500 per year or \$2,200 per year (MCC). To apply complete the following steps:

1. Prepare and type a personal letter of application addressed to the Williams Foundation Scholarship Committee. This letter should include:
 - a) Where you plan to attend college.
 - b) What you plan to major in at college.
 - c) What career field you plan to enter and why.
 - d) Why you feel you merit consideration for a scholarship award.
 - e) The names of the FMHS Scholarships you are applying for.
2. One letter of recommendation from someone you know well. This may be a teacher, employer, neighbor, minister or professional person. The letter should not come from your counselor or your Gear UP Advisor.
3. Request and attach an **official unsealed** transcript from the FMHS Counseling Office. Make sure to note it is for the Williams Scholarship.
4. Letter of acceptance or verification of application from your college/university.
5. Complete summary of Scholarships applied and awarded for located on website.
6. **Application deadline: On or before April 10, 2017. Return to Mrs. Fowler in the Counseling Office.**

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
